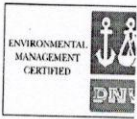

To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as a Special Resolution:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to Sections 23, 42, 62(1)(c) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, and the rules framed thereunder, including any amendment thereto or statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force (**“Companies Act, 2013”**) and applicable provisions, if any of the Companies Act, 1956 (without reference to the provisions thereof that have ceased to have effect upon notification of the Companies Act, 2013 (collectively the **“Companies Act”**), the provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2009, as amended from time to time (**“SEBI ICDR Regulations”**), the relevant provisions of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and the provisions of the Foreign Exchange Management Act, 1999, Foreign Exchange Management (Transfer or Issue of Security by a Person Resident Outside India) Regulations, 2000, the Issue of Foreign Currency Convertible Bonds and Ordinary Shares (Through Depository Receipt Mechanism) Scheme, 1993 (**“FEMA Regulations”**) as amended from time to time and such other statutes, notifications, clarifications, circulars, rules and regulations as may be applicable and relevant, as amended from time to time, issued by the Government of India (**“GOI”**), the Reserve Bank of India (**“RBI”**), the Foreign Investment Promotion Board (**“FIPB”**), the Securities and Exchange Board of India (**“SEBI”**), the stock exchanges where the approval, consent, permission, and/or sanction, which may be agreed/ accepted by the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as the **“Board”**) which shall be deemed to include any committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitutes to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution) consent of the members be and is hereby authorised to create, offer, issue and allot (including with provisions for reservation on firm and/or competitive basis, of such part of issue and for such categories of persons including employees of the Company as may be permitted), either in India or in the course of international offering(s) in one or more foreign markets, such number of Equity Shares, global depository receipts (**“GDRs”**), American depository receipts (**“ADRs”**), foreign currency convertible bonds (**“FCCBs”**), other financial instruments convertible into Equity Shares, any security convertible into Equity Shares with or without voting/special rights, securities linked to Equity Shares and/or securities with or without detachable warrants with right exercisable by the warrant holders to convert or subscribe to Equity Shares (hereinafter collectively referred to as **“Securities”**) or any combination of Securities, upto Rs. 250 Crores (Rupees two hundred fifty crores only) or equivalent thereof in one or more tranches, whether rupee denominated or denominated in foreign currency by way of one or more public and/or private offerings and/or on a preferential allotment basis including Qualified Institutions Placement (**“QIP”**) or any combination thereof, through issue of prospectus, and/or placement document and/or any other permissible/requisite offer document at a discount or premium to market price or prices permitted under applicable law on such terms and conditions including security, rate of interest, etc., to domestic/ foreign investors, institutional investors, foreign institutional investors, foreign portfolio investors, non-resident Indians, Indian public, individuals, companies / corporate bodies (whether incorporated in India or abroad), mutual funds, banks, insurance companies, pension funds, venture capital funds, foreign venture capital funds, financial institutions, trusts, qualified institutional buyers (**“QIBs”**) within the meaning of regulation 2(1)(zd) of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, whether shareholders of the company or not as may be deemed appropriate by the Board at its absolute discretion including the discretion to determine the categories of Investors to whom 1. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 setting out details relating to Special Business at the meeting is annexed hereto.
2. A MEMBER OF THE COMPANY ENTITLED TO ATTEND AND VOTE AT THE EXTRA ORDINARY GENERAL MEETING (THE MEETING) OF THE COMPANY IS ENTITLED TO APPOINT A PROXY TO ATTEND AND VOTE INSTEAD OF HIMSELF/HERSELF AT THE MEETING AND SUCH PROXY NEED NOT BE A MEMBER OF THE COMPANY. THE INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A PROXY, IN ORDER TO BE EFFECTIVE MUST BE DEPOSITED AT THE REGISTERED OFFICE OF THE COMPANY, DULY COMPLETED AND SIGNED NOT LESS THAN 48 HOURS BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE MEETING.
3. Members are requested to note that a person can act as proxy on behalf of the Members not exceeding 50 (fifty) and holding in aggregate not more than 10% (ten percent) of the total share capital of the Company. A Member holding more than 10% (ten percent) of the total share capital of the Company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy and such person shall not act as a proxy for any other shareholder.
4. Members/Proxies are requested to bring the Attendance Slip(s) duly filled in for attending the Meeting. They are requested to affix their signatures at the space provided on the Attendance Slip and hand over the Attendance Slip at the entrance of the meeting hall.
5. Corporate Members/Trusts/Societies etc. intending to send their authorised representatives to attend the meeting are requested to send a duly certified copy of the Board/Managing Committee Resolution authorising their representative to attend and vote on their behalf at the meeting.
6. All documents referred to in the Notice and the Explanatory Statement will be available for inspection at the Registered Office during business hours on all working days, up to and including the date of the Meeting of the Company.

7. The Notice is being sent to all the Shareholders, whose names appear on the Register of Members/List of Beneficial Owners as received from M/s Karvy Computershare Pvt. Ltd. (RTA) as on Friday, 21st April, 2017.
8. The Company has appointed Mr. S.Chidambaram, Company Secretary in Practice, Hyderabad (Certificate of Practice No. 2286) to act as the Scrutinizer, to scrutinize the remote e-voting process and voting process at the meeting in a fair and transparent manner. The Members desiring to vote through remote e-voting may refer to the detailed procedure given hereunder.

Procedure for remote e-voting :

- I. The Company has engaged the services of Karvy Computershare Private Limited (Karvy) for facilitating remote e-voting for EGM. The instructions for remote e-voting are as under:
 - (a) In case of Members receiving an e-mail from Karvy :
 - (i) Launch an internet browser and open <https://evoting.karvy.com>.
 - (ii) Enter the login credentials (i.e. User ID and password). The Event No.+Folio No. or DP ID- Client ID will be your User ID. However, if you are already registered with Karvy for e-voting, you can use your existing User ID and password for casting your vote.
 - (iii) After entering the above details Click on - Login.
 - (iv) Password change menu will appear. Change the Password with a new Password of your choice.  - (viii) Cast your vote by selecting appropriate option and click on 'Submit'. Click on 'OK' when prompted.
 - (ix) Upon confirmation, the message 'Vote cast successfully' will be displayed.
 - (x) Once you have voted on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

- II. In case of any queries, you may refer to the 'Frequently Asked Questions' (FAQs) and 'e-voting user manual' available in the downloads section of Karvy's e-voting website <https://evoting.karvy.com>.
- III. If you are already registered with Karvy for e-voting then you can use your existing User ID and Password for casting vote.
- IV. The voting rights shall be as per the number of equity share(s) held by the Member(s) as on 19th May, 2017. Members are eligible to cast vote electronically only if they are holding shares as on that date.

This special resolution contained in the Notice relates to a resolution by the Company enabling the Board to create, issue, offer and allot Equity Shares, GDRs, ADRs, FCCBs and such other securities convertible into equity shares as stated in the resolution (the "Securities"), including by way of a qualified institutions placement in accordance with Chapter VIII of the SEBI ICDR Regulations, in one or more tranches, at such price and on such terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by the Board at its absolute discretion including the discretion to determine the categories of Investors to whom the issue, offer, and allotment shall be made considering the prevalent market conditions and other relevant factors and wherever necessary, in consultation with lead manager(s) and other agencies that may be appointed by the Board of Directors (hereinafter referred to as the "Board" which shall be deemed to include any committee which the Board may have constituted or hereinafter constitutes to exercise its powers including the powers conferred by this resolution) for the purpose of the Issue.

This special resolution enables the Board to issue Securities for an aggregate amount upto Rs.250 Crores (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty Crores only) or its equivalent in any foreign currency.

The Board shall issue Securities pursuant to this special resolution and utilize the proceeds for business purposes, including but not limited to repayment of long term and short term debt, to fund the organic and inorganic growth of the Company, to meet working capital requirements of the Company and general corporate purposes.

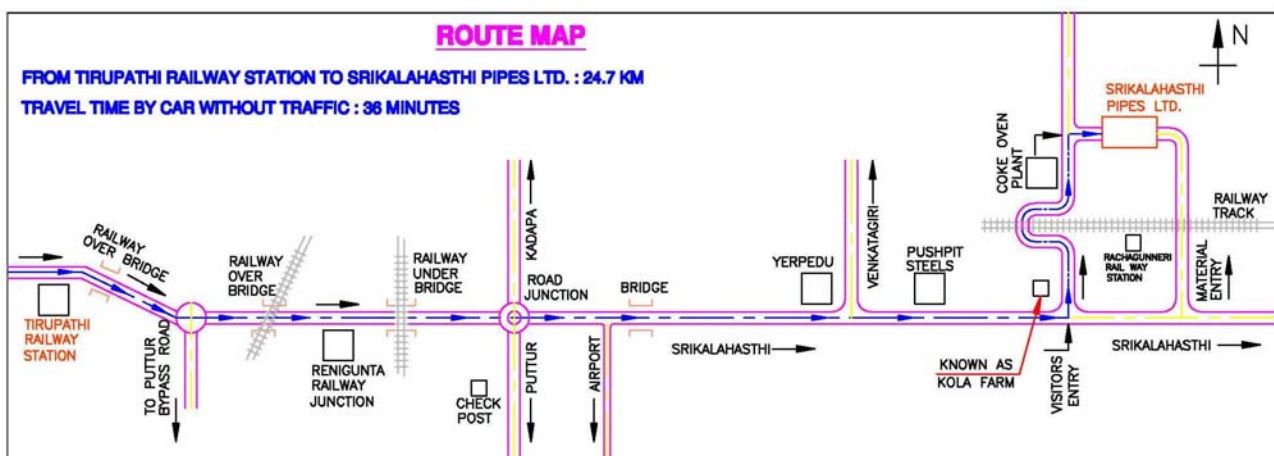

Indore, May 3

The downtrend in pulse seeds and pulses continued on slack physical demand and buying support. Amid adequate availability of domestic and imported crops, tur (Maharashtra) prices in Indore mandis on Wednesday declined to ₹3,950 (down ₹100 from last week).

Tur (Madhya Pradesh) on the other hand ruled at ₹3,600 a quintal.

Tur dal ruled stable with tur dal (sawa no.) being quoted at ₹5,600-5,700, while tur dal (full) was quoted at ₹6,100-₹6,500 a quintal. Slack physical demand and a rise in arrival of new summer moong dragged moong in Indore mandis, with a decline to ₹4,500-4,700 a quintal in moong (best - down ₹200 from last week), while moong (medium) ruled at ₹4,000 a quintal.

Downtrend continues in MCX-Nickel

The Nickel futures contract on the Multi Commodity Exchange (MCX) has failed to sustain the bounceback witnessed in the past week.

The contract saw a low of ₹587.2 per kg on April 27 and had bounced higher from there.

But this bounceback was shortlived and the contract has reversed sharply lower after making a high of ₹619 per kg on Monday.

It has tumbled about 3 per cent from this high and is currently trading at around ₹601. Immediate support is at ₹598.

If the contract manages to sustain above this support, it can bounce to ₹615 and ₹620 levels once again.

The 21-day moving average and a trend-line support at ₹624 is a crucial support to watch. The downside pres-

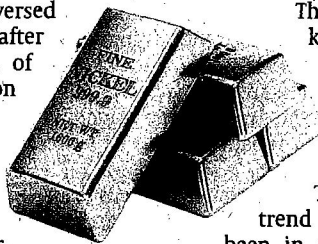
sure will ease if the contract manages to surpass this hurdle. In such a scenario the contract can extend its up-move to ₹635 or even ₹640 levels.

On the other hand, if the MCX-Nickel futures contract fails to reverse higher from the immediate support at ₹598, it can remain under pressure and fall to ₹590 levels once again.

This will also keep the contract under pressure for a further fall.

The downtrend that has been in place since March will remain intact in such a scenario and there will be a strong likelihood of the contract falling to ₹570 or even to ₹550 levels in the coming weeks.
