## TO THE MEMBERS OF BHORUKA ALUMINIUM LIMITED

## Report on the Financial Statements

1. We have audited the accompanying financial statements of BHORUKA ALUMINIUM LIMITED ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at $3{ }^{\text {st }}$ March, 2016, the Statement of Profit and Loss, the Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

## Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

2. The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in Section 134(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") with respect to the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014. (b) unsecured interest free loan given to $100 \%$ wholly owned overseas subsidiary Bhoruka Aluminium FZE, UAE, amounting to Rs. $4,16,67,054$ has been written off in the Profit and Loss Account of previous year without the approval of RBI consequent to wound up of the said subsidiary; (Refer notes no. 22 to financial statements under sl.no.11)
