ORDINARY BUSINESS:

1. To consider and adopt (a) the audited financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2017 and the reports of the Board of Directors and Auditors thereon; and (b) the audited consolidated financial statement of the Company for the financial year ended March 31, 2017 and the report of Auditors thereon and in this regard, pass the following resolutions as **Ordinary Resolutions**:

6. 10. 16. **Remote e-voting** – Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act read with relevant Rules of the Act and Securities & Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirement) Regulations, 2015, the Company is pleased to provide to its members facility to exercise their right to vote on Resolutions proposed to be passed in the 26th Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) by electronic means. The members may cast their votes using an electronic voting system from a place other than the venue of the AGM (‘remote e-voting’). The facility for voting shall also be made available at the AGM and the members attending the AGM who have not cast their vote by remote e-voting shall be able to vote at the AGM. The members who have cast their vote by remote e-voting may attend the AGM but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again.

The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) to provide e-voting facilities and for security and enabling the members to cast their vote in a secure manner. It may be noted that this e-voting facility is optional. The e-voting facility will be available during the following voting period:

Commencement of e-voting : From 9.00 A.M. of Sep 20, 2017

End of e-voting : Up to 5.00 P.M. of Sep 22, 2017

E-Voting shall not be allowed beyond 5.00 p.m. of Sep 22, 2017. During the e-voting period, Shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date may cast their vote electronically.

In terms of requirements of the Act, and the relevant Rules, Company has fixed Saturday, September 16, 2017 as the ‘Cut-off Date’. The remote e-voting / voting rights of the shareholders/ beneficial owners shall be reckoned on the equity shares held by them as on the Cut-off Date i.e. September 16, 2017 only.

A person who is not a member as on the Cut-off Date should treat this Notice for information purpose only. Only members as on Cut-off Date, who have not exercised their voting rights through remote e-voting, shall be entitled to vote at the meeting.

Subject to receipt of requisite number of votes, the Resolutions shall be deemed to be passed on the date of the AGM, i.e. Saturday, September 23, 2017.

Once the vote on a resolution is cast by a member, the member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently or cast the vote again.

The Scrutinizer, after scrutinising the votes cast at the AGM and through remote e-voting, will, not later than 2(two) days of conclusion of the AGM, make a consolidated Scrutinizer’s report and submit the same to the Chairman. The results declared along with the consolidated Scrutinizer’s report shall be placed on the website of the Company www.lakshmiroup.in and on the website of CDSL e-Voting. The results shall simultaneously be communicated to the concerned Stock Exchanges, where the securities of the Company are listed.

Statement Annexed to the Notice in respect of the Special Business pursuant to Section 102 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“Act”)

Item No. 4

Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal is a Promoter and Managing Director of the Company. Board in its meeting held on 12th August, 2017 has, subject to the approval of members, approved the re-appointment of Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal, as Managing Director for a further period of 3 years w.e.f 1st September 2017. The aforesaid reappointment shall be subject to the approval of the members.

The Board in its meeting held on 12th August, 2017, on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, approved the remuneration (as set out in the resolution) payable to Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal.

Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal satisfy all the conditions set out in Part-I of Schedule V to the Act as also conditions set out under sub-section (3) of Section 196 of the Act for being eligible for his re-appointment. He is not disqualified from being appointed as Directors in terms of Section 164 of the Act.

The above may be treated as a written memorandum setting out the terms of re-appointment of Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal under Section 190 of the Act.

Brief resume of Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal, nature of his expertise in specific functional areas, names of companies in which he hold directorships and memberships / chairmanships of Board Committees, shareholding and relationships amongst directors inter-se as stipulated under **Regulation 36 (3) of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure requirements) Regulations, 2015** forms integral part of the Notice.

The Board recommends the Special Resolution (regarding reappointment of Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal as Managing Director) for the approval by the Shareholders of the Company.

Mr. Balbir Singh Uppal himself, Mr. Janak Raj Singh, Joint Managing Director being related to him, may be deemed to be interested/ concerned in the Special Resolution set out at Item No.4 of the Notice.

I. General Information

1.) Nature of Industry:

Lakshmi Energy and Foods Limited is in the business of manufacturing of Rice, Edible Oils, De-oiled Cakes and Generation of Electricity Power from bio-waste. Reasons of loss	On account of prevailing recessionary conditions worldwide, the Company's operations have also come under stress on account of Reduction in the market prices of Paddy and Rice. There has been sharp fall in the market prices of basmati paddy as well as rice in the last 2 years. The fall in prices is mainly attributed to higher production of basmati coupled with tepid international demand particularly due to import restrictions by countries like Iran. Reduction in market price of paddy and rice led to substantial fall in the valuation of Inventory and operations and profitability of the company.
Steps taken or proposed to be taken for improvement	In order to mitigate losses, company is actively involved in the adopting ways and means to reduce the finance cost. The company is in the process of implementation of S4A (Scheme for Sustainable Structuring of Stressed Assets) under the RBI guidelines which will substantially reduce the interest burden.
Expected increase in productivity and profits in measurable terms	In addition to steps proposed to be taken for improvement as detailed hereinabove, the focus would be on improvement on manufacturing efficiencies, cost optimization and investment in human resource thereby achieving increase in productivity and maximization of profits. 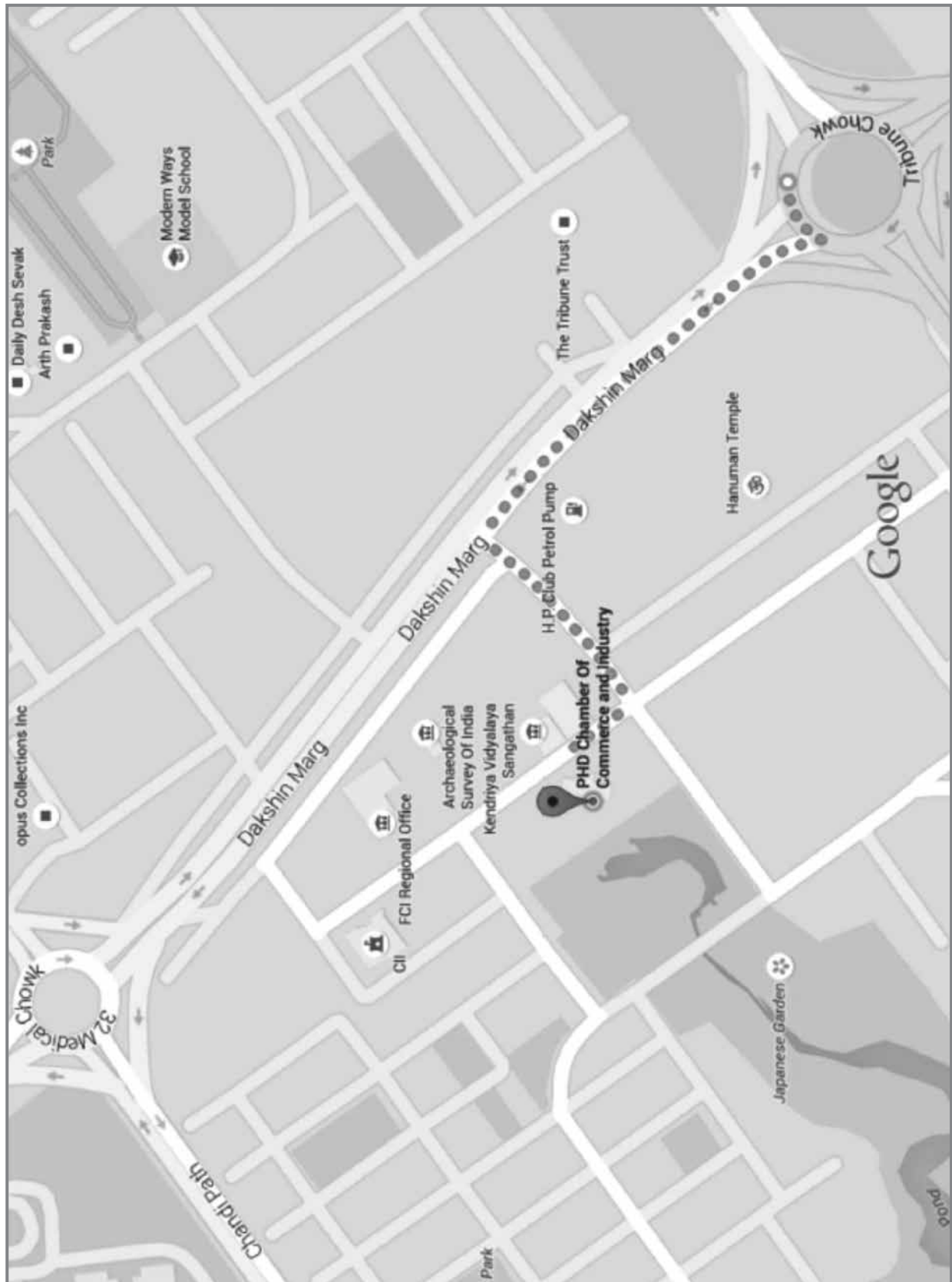
