PM security breach: SC panel says SSP was clearly told to secure route

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Thursday made public the Justice Indu Malhotra committee's report indicating then Ferrozpur SSP Harmandeep Singh Hans for serious lapses in duty which resulted in PM Narendra Modi's convoy getting stranded on a flyover in Punjab on January 5.



The report, submitted a few weeks ago to the SC, was opened in court by a bench of CJN V Ramana and Justices Surya Kant and Hima Kohli and it was revealed that it gave detailed findings related to lapses on Hans' part. CJ Ramana read out a portion of the findings: "Harmandeep Singh Hans, then SSP Ferrozpur, failed to discharge his responsibilities to maintain law and order; he did not take steps for deployment to strengthen the route in Ferrozpur even though he was fully aware there were large hostile groups who had come to block the route."

BJP blames Channi govt for 'conspiracy'

BJP asserted that the breach was "planned" and not a "natural one", and those behind the conspiracy and their motives should be unmasked. I&B minister Anurag Thakur raised a series of questions about the role of former Punjab CM and Congress leader Charanjit Singh Channi and asked why top functionaries were missing from the spot where the PM's convoy was stranded. "The CM gave the excuse that he was suffering from Covid, but he addressed a press conference after a few hours and met people without a mask, Channi said it was natural. It was not natural but planned. Who was behind this conspiracy?" Thakur asked.

The committee said, "Hans failed to augment and strengthen the route in Ferrozpur even though there were sufficient forces available with him. There was sufficient time available with him when [ADGP] G Nagaswara Rao informed Hans about the PM taking the contingency route and that the route should be adequately strengthened. Despite clear instructions from Rao, at least two hours before the PM entered the district of Ferrozpur, the SSP failed to act on the instructions of Rao." The bench said the committee has recommended strengthening and improving the security mechanism for PM and VVIPs detailed in the 'Blue Book', which is issued by the home ministry, as well as regular refresher and sensitisation courses for training police officers on such security measures.

Eye on China, Navy pushes for third, biggest aircraft carrier

It Will Take At Least A Decade To Construct

With China aggressively building new aircraft carriers and a blue-water navy to counter the US and project power around the globe, the Indian Navy is now pushing hard for its long-standing case for a third and much bigger aircraft carrier to retain its combat edge in the Indian Ocean Region (IOR). With India's first indigenous aircraft carrier (IAC) set to be commissioned as the 45,000-tonne INS Vikrant on September 2, the Navy believes the project for a third carrier should be launched as soon as possible since it will take at least a decade to build a 65,000-tonne one. The force has for long said three carriers are needed to ensure at least two are operationally available, one each for the eastern and western seaboard, while the third undergoes its maintenance-and-refit cycle. India, incidentally, has been without an operational aircraft carrier for almost two years now since the 44,500-

tonne INS Vikramaditya, acquired from Russia for \$2.33 billion in November 2013, is undergoing a major refit. "The indigenous ecosystem has been created by building the IAC. The stage is now well set to take the next step forward to indigenously build the next aircraft carrier to ensure the expertise gained is utilised to the maximum in times to come," Navy vice chief Vice Admiral Satish N Ghormade said on Thursday. INS Vikrant, once fully combat-ready by mid-2023, will play a role in ensuring peace and stability in the Indo-Pacific region. "Commissioning of the carrier will provide the required deterrence, considering the growing strength of our neighbours, and enhance our maritime capability," he added. After building the Rs 20,000-crore IAC, which took 13 years from keel-laying to delivery after being first sanctioned by the government way back in January 2003, the Cochin Shipyard (CSL) is all gung ho for the next carrier project. "Now, once we get the go-ahead, we can build a warship similar to IAC in eight years. We can even build a 65,000-tonne carrier since our new 300-meter dry dock will be ready by 2024," CSL CMD Madhu S Nair told TOI.

Sputnik V takers can opt for desi booster: Ministry

New Delhi: People who have taken two doses of Sputnik V vaccine and are not able to get the third dose of the vaccine due to supply-related problems can opt for Covaxin or Covishield as a precautionary dose, the health ministry has clarified, reports Durgesh Nandan Jha. "One can take any of the available vaccines as a precautionary dose if Sputnik V isn't available," said a senior official. A senior official from Fortis healthcare said Sputnik V has been out of supply at their hospital for the past one month. "We are administering other available vaccines as precautionary doses," he said. At Apollo hospital, an official said, they are not yet clear on the policy. "We have not received fresh supplies of the Sputnik V vaccines for almost a month," the official said.

Hyderabad: Nearly 150 housefly larvae were removed from the nose of a Covid and mucormycosis survivor at a Hyderabad hospital after she landed there in a critical condition. The 50-year-old housewife from Andhra Pradesh's Guntur contracted Covid around six months ago and later developed mucormycosis. After the infection spread to her brain, her right eye had to be removed. Covid impaired her kidney function and triggered diabetes. When the patient was wheeled into a hospital recently she was in semicomatose and in delirium. Examination revealed the presence of maggots just below the brain. Since mucormycosis resulted in her losing sensation around the nose, the woman couldn't feel when houseflies landed on the affected area. The doctors said the woman has now completely recovered.

Friend, PA detained for Phogat's murder

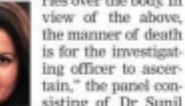

Panaji: After initial reluctance, Goa police on Thursday registered a murder case in the death of Haryana BJP politician Sonali Phogat and have booked two persons, who had accompanied her to Goa. The murder case was registered after the postmortem revealed "multiple blunt force injuries" over Phogat's body. She had died at Anjuna on Tuesday morning and the postmortem was conducted on Thursday, after her family finally gave their consent. "We have booked Phogat's PA Sudhir Sangwan and her friend Sukhwinder in connection with the murder," Anjuna PI Prashal Dessai said. Both have been detained and police are interrogating them. "It is an earmarked case, SP North will be personally monitoring the investigations," DGP Jaspal Singh told TOI. However, the panel of Goa Medical College doctors who conducted the postmortem have reserved the cause of death.



"The cause of death and belief is reserved pending chemical analysis, histopathology and serological reports of the tissues preserved. However, there are multiple blunt force injuries over the body. In view of the above, the manner of death is for the investigating officer to ascertain," the panel consisting of Dr Sunil Chimbolkar and Dr Mandar Kantak said. "The multiple blunt force injuries over the body were below the skin and were not noticed after the incision on the body was made. It is likely to have been caused six hours prior to her death, a forensic official said. "The injuries may have been caused by fist blows or due to a fall. The injuries were fresh," the forensic official said. Phogat's body was handed over to the family to perform final rites and the family has left the state with her mortal remains.

When asked about the attack a few weeks ago, foreign minister S Jaishankar had said in Bengaluru that it was something "the whole world has noticed and the whole world has reacted to such an attack". In a media briefing on Thursday, external affairs ministry spokesperson Arindam Bagchi said India had always stood against violence and extremism. "We condemn the horrific attack on Salman Rushdie and we wish him a speedy recovery," he added. Rushdie spent years in hiding after Iran's supreme leader, Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini, issued a fatwa in 1989 calling for his death. Following the attack, Iran denied any link with the attacker.

While Indian foreign ministry spokesperson Arindam Bagchi said on Thursday that India is looking forward to recruiting Gorkha soldiers under the Agnipath scheme, Nepal foreign minister Narayan Khadka was reported to have asked Indian ambassador Naveen Srivastava to "postpone" recruitment of Nepal youth. The Indian side was ready to start recruitment on August 25 but that process will now have to wait. local authorities claiming the scheme is a violation of the tripartite agreement. According to sources, Nepal had raised this issue with both the MEA and also Indian Army seeking "clarifications" on how the scheme, which led to massive protests even in India, will be implemented. These concerns will likely be amplified by Nepal authorities ahead of Indian Army chief Manoj Pande's visit to Nepal early next month. Nepal was apparently not consulted by Indian authorities before the scheme was announced. According to Nepal authorities, and as per the tripartite agreement, all recruits must be allowed to serve for long enough to qualify for pension "subject to satisfactory performance and conduct".

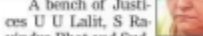

SC defers Teesta bail hearing till Aug 30

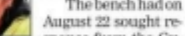
New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Thursday said it would examine whether incarceration of social activist Teesta Setalvad was required in the case of forgery and criminal conspiracy lodged against her in connection with the 2002 Gujarat riots and posted the case for hearing on August 30. A bench of Justices U U Lalit, S Ravindra Bhat and Sudhanshu Dhulia adjourned the hearing for next week after the Gujarat government sought two days' more time to file response on Teesta's plea. While pleading for an adjournment, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta said there was no urgency in the case and it could be heard



next week. He said it was not a special case. The bench, however, said there is nothing special about the case but someone is behind bars and that is the reason for urgency. It said the present combination of bench would not be available on Monday and the case could be heard only on Tuesday. The bench had on August 22 sought response from the Gujarat government on Setalvad's plea. The case was registered against her and former IPS officers after the apex court had on June 24 questioned the role of disgruntled officers of Gujarat and some activists to keep the pot boiling in the 2002 riots case.
