## STANDALONE NOTES

1. (a) Income from Operations for the current quarter at Rs.175 crores, increased by 4% over the corresponding quarter of previous year driven by higher turnover from Plantation products.  
(b) The Profit from Operations for the current quarter at Rs.27 crores is higher by 9% compared to corresponding quarter of the previous year due to improved performance of the Plantations business.
2. The Net Profit for the current quarter ended 30th June, 2015 is at Rs.20 crores compared to Rs.19 crores for the corresponding quarter of the previous year, driven by improved operational performance.
3. With effect from 27.01.2015, the face value of the Company's Equity share has been subdivided from Rs.10/- to Rs.1/-. Consequent to the above change, the Earnings Per Share for the corresponding quarter of previous year has been re-computed based on the revised number of shares.
4. In view of the seasonal nature of the Plantation activity, as per policy consistently followed, a portion of the Company's plantation related costs have been carried forward and will be charged during the period when the crop is harvested.
5. The figures for the previous periods are regrouped /re-arranged wherever necessary.
6. The aforementioned results were reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board and subsequently taken on record by the Board of Directors at its Meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.

**Independent Auditor's Review Report**

To  
The Board of Directors  
Tata Coffee Ltd.

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited consolidated statement of financial results of Tata Coffee Ltd (the Company) and its subsidiary (together the Group) for the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015, attached herewith, except for the disclosures regarding 'Public Shareholding' and 'Promoter and Promoter Group Shareholding' which have been traced from the records furnished to us by the management and have not been reviewed by us. This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, Engagements to review financial information issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of the company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We did not review the interim financial statements of the subsidiary included in the consolidated financial results whose interim financial statements reflect total assets (net) of Rs. 157894 lakhs as at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015 as well as total revenue (net) of Rs.22125 Lakhs and profit after tax of Rs.1081 Lakhs for the quarter as considered in the consolidated financial results. These interim financial results and other financial information have been limited reviewed by the other auditor and we have relied on the same. Our opinion on the financial results for the period ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015 to the extent they have been derived from such interim financial results is based solely on the report of the other auditors.

Based on our review conducted as above nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited Consolidated financial results prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and other recognized accounting practices and policies has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

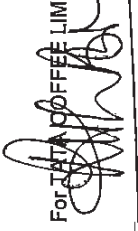

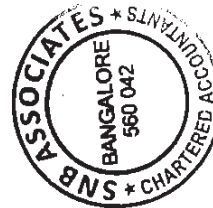
