"It is beyond any reasonable understanding that Delhi Police chief who chooses to remain silent when any AAP leader or volunteer is attacked, came forward to give a surprising statement, virtually blaming Alka for the incident," the statement added.

However, reacting on the CCTV footage, senior AAP leader Ashutosh said, "In politics, one should exercise restraint."

They also contended that there was an inexplicable delay in lodging of FIR and that there was no eyewitness to the crime they were charged for.

It also observed that "non-joining of public witnesses does not falsify the prosecution case. It is a matter of common experience that public persons are reluctant to assist police in the investigation".
