MTPL has claimed costs incurred and compensation in line with the terms of the Concession Agreement from the authorities. MTPL has been legally advised that it has a strong case on merits to recover such claims. The management is confident that it would be able to recover a substantial amount of such claims within a reasonable timeframe.
