- 1. Implementation of project for 100% BS-IV compliant MS and HSD production facilities at Barauni Refinery at an estimated cost of Rs.1,327 crore and to carry out pre-project activities and preparation of Detailed Feasibility Report at a cost of Rs.112 crore. This would enable availability of BS-IV products as per the Govt. of India roadmap for implementation of Euro-IV complaint MS and HSD all over the country effective 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2017.
