- Revenue for the quarter is Rs 1,140.8 crore as compared to Rs 962.2 crore in the corresponding quarter of previous year, a growth of 19%
- Core Earning Before Interest, Depreciation, Tax & Ammortisation (EBIDTA) excluding other income for the quarter is Rs 103.8 crore as compared to Rs 91.1 crore in the corresponding quarter of previous year, a growth of 14%
