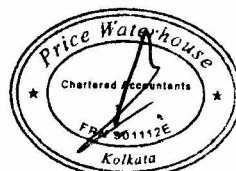

- 2 (a) Pending disposal (consented by the shareholders in March, 2006) of the Company's Hindusthan Heavy Chemicals Unit, the revenue / expenses of the unit (insignificant in terms of the Company's total revenue / expenses) have been and will be included in these and subsequent results till its disposal).

(b) The Company had to declare suspension of work at the unit effective 8th December, 2010 in consequence of illegal strike/activities by workmen.
- 3 "Finance Costs" include mark-to-market losses of Rs. 4.88 crore recognised on account of composite currency swap deal and Rs. 0.52 crore on account of interest rate swap deal.

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- 5 The company is in the process of technically evaluating useful lives of its fixed assets vis-à-vis the useful lives stated under Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013. Pending such evaluation, depreciation for the quarter and half year ended 30th September, 2014 has been calculated by applying the rates that were applicable for the previous financial year. On completion of the technical evaluation of estimated life of fixed assets the difference (presently unascertainable) between depreciation using previous years applicable depreciation rates and as per Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013 will be adjusted in subsequent period.
- 6 The management had carried out an impairment testing as at March 31, 2014 for its tyre division, and no impairment loss was identified. However, no such impairment testing has been conducted as at September 30, 2014 as the same will be carried out as at the year end.
- 7 The Company is exploring options for reorganising and realigning its existing businesses. It has, for these purposes, constituted a Core Committee comprising three Directors, two of whom are independent, to consider and evaluate steps that the Company may need to pursue to implement such reorganisation and realignment. This process of evaluation is under way.
- 8 The Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out the Limited Review of the above unaudited financial results for the quarter and half year ended 30th September 2014 in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement.
- 9 Figures for the comparable periods have been re-grouped / re-classified wherever considered necessary.

We have reviewed the results of Kesoram Industries Limited (the “Company”) for the quarter ended September 30, 2014 which are included in the accompanying ‘Statement of unaudited financial results for the quarter and half year ended 30th September, 2014’ and the statement of assets and liabilities as on that date (the “Statement”), except for the disclosures regarding ‘Public Shareholding’ and ‘Promoter and Promoter Group Shareholding’ which have been traced from disclosures made by the Management but have neither been reviewed nor been audited by us. The Statement has been prepared by the Company pursuant to Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement with the Stock Exchanges in India, which has been initialled by us for identification purposes. This Statement is the responsibility of the Company’s management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
2. We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, “*Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity*” issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement.
3. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion
4. We have only traced the disclosures regarding ‘Public Shareholding’ and ‘Promoter and Promoter Group Shareholding’ in the Statement from the disclosures made by the Management and are, therefore, not expressing a review opinion thereon.
5. We draw your attention to the following matters:
 - (a) Note 5 to the Statement which states that the Company is in the process of technically evaluating useful lives of its fixed assets. Pending such technical evaluation, the depreciation for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2014 has been calculated by the Company based on the rates applicable to the previous financial year. We are unable to ascertain the impact, if any, on tangible fixed assets, depreciation and amortization expense and reserves and surplus that may have arisen had such depreciation been computed based on the useful lives of fixed assets.
 - (b) Note 6 to the Statement relating to the non testing and non ascertainment of impairment provision with respect to the tyre business of the Company as at September 30, 2014, which is not in compliance with the requirements of AS 28, Impairment of Assets. We are unable to ascertain the impact, if any, on other expenses, fixed asset and reserves and surplus that may have arisen had such impairment testing been carried out on the tyre business division.



6. Based on our review conducted as above, except for the indeterminate effects of the matters set out in in paragraph 5 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the Statement has not been prepared in all material respects in accordance with the applicable Accounting Standards notified pursuant to the Companies (Accounting Standards) Rules, 2006 as per Section 211(3C) of the Companies Act, 1956 read with the General Circular 15/2013 dated September 13, 2013 of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs in respect of Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies, and has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
