Notes:

- 1. The results were reviewed by the Audit Committee, approved and taken on record at the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Company held on 13/08/2014.
- 2. The Company's operations and its results vary from period to period, depending on the delivery schedule of the customers.
- 3. In accordance with the requirements of Accounting Standard 7 notified by the Companies Accounting Standard Rules, 2006 the Company has recognised unbilled revenue of Rs.719.63 lacs during the quarter ended 30/06/2014 (Preceding 3 months ended 31/03/2014 Rs. 2102.30 lacs and Corresponding 3 months ended 30/06/2013 Rs.953.54 lacs) in respect of high value long delivery orders which are delivered in parts over the execution period. The unbilled revenue is calculated based on percentage of completion of individual contracts.
- 4. The Company's business activity falls within a single business segment i.e Engineering, hence the disclosure requirement as per AS-17 'Segment Reporting' is not attracted.
- 5. The Company holds equity shares of Mcnally Bharat Engineering Company Limited (Book Value Rs.1,993.45 lacs) as strategic investment on a long term basis. The Company is of the view that the diminution in value of Rs.1,162.20 lacs (as at 31/03/2014 of Rs. 1,409.95 lacs and 30/06/2013 of Rs. 1,614.13 lacs) in these investments is temporary. Notwithstanding this, a provision of Rs.400 lacs had been made in the books during the prior years (including Rs. 200 Lacs in Quarter and year ended 31/03/2014). This has been qualified by the Auditors in their periods presented.

- 6. The figures of the quarter ended 31/03/2014 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the third quarter of the relevant financial year.
- 7.Consequent to the enactment of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) and its applicability for accounting periods commencing on or after 01/04/2014, the Company has reassessed the useful lives of fixed assets to align with Schedule II to the Act. Where the remaining useful life of an asset is nil, the carrying amount of the asset after retaining the residual value, as at 01/04/2014 of Rs.11 lacs (net of deferred tax) has been adjusted against the opening balance of retained earnings. In other cases the carrying values have been depreciated over the remaining useful livesof the assets and recognized in the Statement of Profit and Loss. As a result the charge for depreciation is higher by Rs.21 lacs for the quarter ended 30/06/2014.
- 8.Previous period / year's figures have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary, to correspond with those of the current period / year's classification.
