The prerequisite for this offer is, that Alstom agrees to give Siemens access to the company's data room and permission to interview the Management during a period of four weeks, to enable Siemens to carry out a suitable due diligence. A letter in this regard was submitted this afternoon to the French company. No further comments will be made at this time.
