NOTES TO CONSOLIDATED UNAUDITED FINANCIAL RESULTS:

- 1. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 10th November, 2014. These have also been reviewed by the Statutory Auditors.
- 2. The actuarial gains and losses on the funds for employee benefits (pension plans) of the overseas subsidiaries have been consistently accounted in "Reserves and Surplus" in the consolidated financial statements in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles applicable and followed in the respective country of incorporation. The Management is of the view that due to volatility and structure of the overseas pension funds, it is not considered practicable to adopt a common accounting policy and deviation is as permitted by Accounting Standard 21 Consolidated Financial Statements. Had the practice of recognising the actuarial gains and losses of pension plans of the overseas subsidiaries in the consolidated financial results been followed, the consolidated Net Profit/(Loss) before tax and Net Profit / (Loss) after tax of the Group would have been higher/(lower) by amounts as per table below:

The Statutory Auditors have invited attention to this Note in their audit report.

3. Pursuant to the provisions of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 effective from 1st April, 2014, the Company has reassessed the useful lives of its fixed assets. The revised useful lives, as assessed by Management, match with those specified in Part C of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013, for all classes of assets other than computers, motor cars and certain classes of buildings, roads and plant and machinery. Management believes that the revised useful lives of the assets reflect the periods over which these assets are expected to be used.

As a result of the change, the charge on account of depreciation for the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2014 is higher by ₹ 6.85 crore and ₹ 14.29 crore respectively. In case of assets whose useful lives have ended, the carrying values, net of residual values as at 1st April, 2014 amounting to ₹ 20.65 crore (net of tax ₹ 10.64 crore) have been adjusted against the opening reserves as on 1st April, 2014.

One of the domestic subsidiaries of the Group has adjusted an amount of $\ref{2.37}$ crore (net of tax $\ref{1.22}$ crore) against the opening reserves as on 1st April, 2014, on this account.

4. During the quarter, a subsidiary was incorporated on 22nd August, 2014 to carry out the distribution activities relating to customers located in Western Europe.

- 5. Exceptional items represents:
 - a. Compensation on voluntary retirement: During the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2014, a sum of ₹ 62.43 crore has been charged on account of redundancies consequent to its decision to scale down operations at Magadi.
 - b. Others (net): For the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2014, primarily includes compensation received on termination of the supply of electricity and steam agreement amounting to ₹ 56.26 crore, in respect of the Group's European operations. The corresponding figure for the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2013 and year ended 31st March, 2014 are ₹ 152.41 crore and ₹ 160.96 crore respectively. Provisions made in respect of specific receivables at Magadi amounting to ₹ 16.06 crore and ₹ 16.43 crore for the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2013 and year ended 31st March, 2014 respectively, have been netted off against the aforesaid.

INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REVIEW REPORT TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TATA CHEMICALS LIMITED

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Consolidated Unaudited Financial Results of Tata Chemical Limited ("the Company"), its subsidiaries and jointly controlled entities (the Company, its subsidiaries and jointly controlled entities constitute "the Group") and its share of the loss of its associate for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to Clause 41 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges, except for the disclosures in Part II Select Information referred to in paragraph 8 below. This Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
- 2. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This Standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of Company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
- 3. The Statement includes the results of the entities listed in Annexure A to the report.
- 4. We did not review the interim financial statements /information / results of thirty two subsidiaries and four jointly controlled entities included in the consolidated financial results, whose interim financial statements /information /results reflect total assets of ₹ 10,898.39 crore as at 30th September 2014, total revenues of ₹ 1,201.29 crore and ₹ 2,391.41 crore for the quarter and half-year ended 30th September 2014 respectively, and total loss after tax of ₹ 8.83 crore and profit after tax of ₹ 5.30 crore for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014 respectively, as considered in the consolidated financial results. These interim financial statements / information / results have been reviewed by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our report on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries, jointly controlled entities, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors.
- 5. The consolidated financial results includes the interim financial statements/information/results of seven subsidiaries and two jointly controlled entities which have not been reviewed/audited by their auditors, whose interim financial statements/ information/results reflect total assets of ₹ 441.53 crore as at 30th September 2014, total revenue of ₹ 131.37 crore and ₹ 245.85 crore for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014, respectively, and total loss after tax of ₹ 43.20 crore and ₹ 92.66 crore for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014, respectively, as considered in the consolidated financial results. The consolidated financial results also includes the Group's share of loss after tax of ₹ 2.28 crore and ₹ 3.42 crore for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014 respectively, as considered in the consolidated financial results, in respect of



an associate, based on their interim financial statements/information/results which have not been reviewed/audited by their auditors.

- 6. Based on our review conducted as stated above and based on the consideration of the reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 4 above and except for the possible effects of the matter described in paragraph 5 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards specified under the Companies Act, 1956 (which are deemed to be applicable as per Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 7. We invite attention to Note 2 of the Statement regarding the accounting of actuarial gains and losses on employee pension funds of overseas subsidiaries in "Reserves and Surplus" in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles applicable in the country of incorporation for the reasons stated therein, as against such gains and losses being accounted in the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss as per the generally accepted accounting principles in India. Had the Group followed the practice of recognising such gains and losses in the Consolidated Statement of Profit and Loss, the Consolidated Net Profit before tax for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014 would have been lower by the ₹ 36.63 crore and ₹ 29.85 crore and the Consolidated Net Profit after tax after minority interest of the Group for the quarter and half- year ended 30th September 2014 would have been lower by ₹ 30.40 crore and ₹ 29.85 crore respectively.
- 8. Further, we also report that we have traced the number of shares as well as the percentage of shareholding in respect of the aggregate amount of public shareholding and the number of shares as well as the percentage of shares pledged/encumbered and non-encumbered in respect of the aggregate amount of promoters and promoter group shareholding in terms of Clause 35 of the Listing Agreements with the Stock Exchanges and the particulars relating to investor complaints disclosed in Part II Select Information for the quarter ended 30th September 2014 of the Statement, from the details furnished by the Registrar.

FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR THE SECOND QUARTER AND HALF YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2014

The Board of Directors at their Meeting held today took on record and approved the Financial Results for the second quarter and half year ended September 30, 2014.

NOTES TO STANDALONE AUDITED FINANCIAL RESULTS:

- 1. The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 10th November, 2014. These have also been audited by the Statutory Auditors.
- 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013 effective from 1st April, 2014, the Company has reassessed the useful lives of its fixed assets. The revised useful lives, as assessed by Management, match with those specified in Part C of Schedule II to the Companies Act, 2013, for all classes of assets other than computers, motor cars and certain classes of buildings, roads and plant and machinery. Management believes that the revised useful lives of the assets reflect the periods over which these assets are expected to be used.

As a result of the change, the charge on account of depreciation for the quarter and half-year ended 30th September, 2014 is higher by $\stackrel{?}{_{\sim}}$ 6.85 crore and $\stackrel{?}{_{\sim}}$ 14.29 crore respectively. In case of assets whose useful lives have ended, the carrying values, net of residual values as at 1st April, 2014 amounting to $\stackrel{?}{_{\sim}}$ 20.65 crore (net of tax $\stackrel{?}{_{\sim}}$ 10.64 crore) have been adjusted against the opening reserves as on 1st April, 2014.

- 3. Formulas used for calculation of Ratios are as follows:
 - a) Debt Service Coverage Ratio = Profit before Depreciation, Interest and Tax / (Interest + Principal repayment of long term loans (net of refinancing))
 - b) Interest Service Coverage Ratio = Profit before Depreciation, Interest and Tax / Interest
