### Report on the Financial Statement

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial statements of **Shricon Industries Limited** ('the Company') which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2016 and the Statement of Profit and Loss and the cash flow statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

### Management's Responsibility for the Standalone Financial Statements

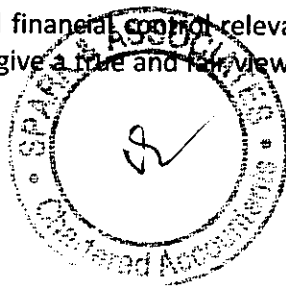

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the financial statements.

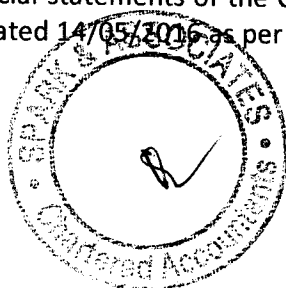
### **Opinion**

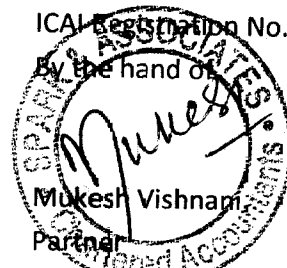

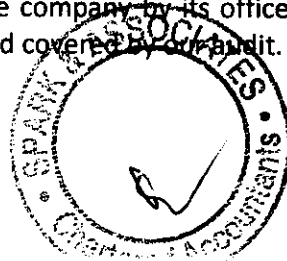

### Auditors' Responsibility

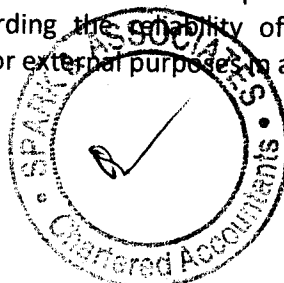
