Report on the Financial Statements

1. Significant Accounting Policies

1.1 Preparation and presentation of financial statement:

a. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention, in accordance with Indian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP), the mandatory accounting standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountant of India and the provisions of the companies Act, 2013, as adopted consistently by the company. All income and expenditure having a material bearing on the financial statements are recognized on the accrual basis.

b. USE OF ESTIMATES

1.2 Fixed Assets & Depreciation:

- Depreciation on the Fixed Assets of the company is provided on Written down value Method as per Schedule II of the Companies Act, 2013.

1.3 Revenue recognition:

- Revenues/Incomes are generally accounted on accrual, as they are earned.
- Sale of goods/Services is recognized on transfer of significant risks and rewards of ownership which is generally on the dispatch of goods.

1.4 Other income:

interest income on term deposits is recognized on accrual basis.

1.5 Expenditure:

Expenses are accounted on the accrual basis and provisions are made for all known losses and liabilities.

1.6 Borrowing costs

Interest and other borrowing costs attributable to qualifying assets are capitalized. Other interest and borrowing costs are charged to Statement of Profit & Loss.

1.7 Internally generated Intangible assets:

Development expenditure incurred at Development phase, where it is reasonably certain that the outcome of the development will be commercially exploited to yield economic benefits to the company, is considered as an intangible asset

1.8 Foreign currency transactions:

Sales/Revenue made to clients outside India is accounted for on the basis of the exchange rate as on the date of transaction.

Foreign currency translation

Foreign currency transactions during the year are recorded at the rates of exchange prevailing on the date of the transaction. Foreign currency denominated assets and liabilities are translated into rupees at the rate of exchange prevailing on the date of balance sheet. All exchange differences are dealt with in the statement of profit and loss.

1.9 Provision, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets:

Provisions involving substantial degree of estimation in measurement and recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past events and it is probable that there will be an outflow or resources, Contingent Liabilities are not recognized but are disclosed in the notes. Contingent Assets are neither recognized not disclosed in the financials statement.

1.10 Income Tax:

Provision for Income Tax is made for both current and deferred taxes. Provision for current income tax is made at current tax rates based on assessable income. Deferred income taxes are recognized for the future tax consequences attributable to timing differences between the financial statement carrying amounts of existing assets and liabilities and there respective tax basis. The effect on deferred tax assets and liabilities of a change in tax rates is recognized using the tax rates and tax laws that have been enacted are substantially enacted by balance sheet date. Deferred tax assets are recognized and carried forward only to the extent that there is reasonable certainty that sufficient future taxable income will be available against which such deferred tax assets can be realized.

1.11 Earnings per share:

- Basic Earnings per Share: In determining earnings per share, the company considers the net profit
 after tax and includes the post-tax effects of any extra-ordinary items. The number of shares used in
 computing the basic earing per share is the weighted average number of shares outstanding during
 the year.
- 2. Dilutive potential equity shares are deemed converted as of the beginning of the period, unless issues at a later date.
