MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS REPORT

ECONOMIC SCENARIO :

As per the advance estimates of GDP for 2009-10 released by the Central Statistical Organisation (CSO), the economy is expected to grow at 7.2 per cent in 2009-10, with the industrial and the service sectors growing at 8.2 and 8.7 per cent respectively.

India's gross domestic product (GDP) grew by 6 per cent during October to December 2009, over the corresponding quarter of the previous year, as per data released by the CSO.

The economic activities which registered significant growth in the third quarter of 2009-10 over the corresponding period in 2008-09 are 'mining and quarrying' at 9.6 per cent, 'manufacturing' at 14.3 per cent, 'construction' at 8.7 per cent, 'trade, hotels, transport and communication' at 10 per cent and 'financing, insurance, real estate and business services' at 7.8 per cent.

INDUSTRY OVERVIEW :

Continuing concerns over Greece sovereign debt default, SEC's allegations against Goldman Sachs, rising crude prices were the key events which dented the investor sentiments in April. However, mostly in-line and in few cases above expectations earnings declared by the listed companies in India gave some comfort to the investors in Indian markets. Both the benchmark indices traded in a narrow range and ended the month with a marginal monthly gain.

Among the sectoral indices, the interest rate sensitive sectors gained the most in April as the RBI increased the CRR less than the market expectations neither did it tighten any lending norms to the Real Estate sector. BSE Realty Index (+6.65%) and BSE Bankex (+4.72%) were the biggest gainers for the month. Rising crude prices meant more pressure on the refining margins of Indian refining companies. This made the BSE Oil & Gas sector (-2.32%), the biggest loser for the month. Concerns over monetary tightening in China dragged the BSE Metals Index down by 1.72% in April.

Globally all the major markets traded narrowly. While the US markets ended the month positively on back of good set of macro data and good Q1 FY 2010 corporate earnings releases, the European markets suffered from macro concerns of Greece, Portugal and Spain.

FII's continued to be strong net buyers in Indian markets in April. FIIs bought approx USD 2.1 bn worth of Equities during the month. However, the DIIs were net sellers in the market to the extent of approx USD 385 mn.

FUTURE OUTLOOK :

As all the benchmark indices have started taking new highs on every other day, it has become challenging for the retail investors to invest in the market. 1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES :

i) BASIS OF ACCOUNTING :

The Company prepares its Accounts on accrual basis, except otherwise stated, in consonance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Policies.

ii) FIXED ASSETS :

Fixed Assets are valued at Cost less Depreciation.

iii) DEPRECIATION :

Depreciation on Other Fixed Assets installed after 16.12.1993, is provided on Straight Line basis at the rates and in the manner specified in the Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956 (As Amended). In respect of the Fixed Assets installed prior to the above date, Depreciation is provided on Straight Line basis at the rates applicable in the respective year of Addition. Statutory Depreciation in respect of Assets where the actual cost does not exceed Rs. 5,000/- is provided at the rate of 100% in the year of Purchase/Installation.

iv) IMPAIRMENT OF ASSETS :

There has been no impairment during the Current Financial Year 2009-10 i.e. the carrying amount of the assets does not exceed the realizable value of the Assets.

v) INVESTMENTS :

a) **CLASSIFICATION** : Investments are classified into the following category :

Long Term Investments : All Investments in Securities, where such investments are intended (at the time of purchase or acquisition thereof) to be held for a period exceeding one year, are classified as Long Term Investments.

b) **VALUATION** :

i) Long Term Investments are valued at cost. Diminution in their values is however, not provided for, since not permanent in nature.

vi) REVENUE RECOGNITION :

a) Fees for Management of Issues and Placement of Securities, if any, are accounted for in accordance with the payment schedule as agreed in Memorandum of Understanding entered into with the Issuer Companies or the Letter of Mandate accepted/signed by them.

b) Dividends and Interest on Debentures are accounted for as and when received.

c) Service Charges for Fund Syndication, if any, are accounted for on completion of Syndication.

vii) TAXATION :

Provision for Income Tax, if any, is made after considering exemptions, deductions and allowances available as per the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

viii) RETIREMENT/GRATUITY BENEFITS :

Retirement benefits in the form of Gratuity is provided in the Profit and Loss Account. Gratuity Liability is a defined benefit/obligation and in the current year such provision has been made on the basis of an actuarial valuation. Such actuarial valuation has been made on the basis of Projected Unit Cost method.

Provident Fund contribution are made to the Employees Provident Fund Scheme of the Government of India. The Company does not have Superannuation Pension Plan since the same is covered by contributions to the Pension Scheme under Employees Provident Fund Act. The Company has not made any investment in Plan Assets towards the Gratuity Liability.
