1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES:

A) SYSTEM OF ACCOUNTING:

- The company follows the mercantile system of accounting and recognises income and expenditure on an accrual basis, except in case of significant uncertainties.
- II) Financial statements are based on historical cost. These costs are not adjusted to reflect the impact of the changing value in the purchasing power of money.

B) REVENUE RECOGNITION

- Discount received in respect of Bills Discounted is apportioned over the period of usance of the instruments.
- II) Interest on delayed payments is accounted on ascertainment of realisability.
- III) Dividends from Mutual Fund are accounted for on the basis of statement received from the Mutual Funds.

C) FIXED ASSETS & DEPRECIATION:

- I) Fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition and other attributable costs less depreciation.
- Depreciation is provided on Written Down Value Method at the rates and in the manner laid down in Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956.
- III) Depreciation on additions/deletions is calculated on a pro-rata basis.

D) BILLS OF EXCHANGE AND LOANS & ADVANCES:
