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


Summary

- Indian large-cap equities declined in April, with the S&P BSE SENSEX down 3%. Smaller and medium Indian companies outperformed, with the S&P BSE SmallCap and S&P BSE MidCap adding 1% each.
- Power has maintained its crown as the performing S&P BSE industry, gaining 18% in April as energy and electricity prices surged higher. The broader Utilities sector also gained 18%, while Information Technology and Teck weighed on returns, dropping 12% each.
- Among Indian equity strategies, the S&P BSE CPSE was the top performer, gaining 4% in April and 12% year-to-date, while S&P BSE SENSEX Futures pulled at the rear, shedding 3% for the month. S&P BSE IPO hasn't recovered its lustre, its 1% gain in April leaves the index still nursing a 14% decline year-to-date.
- The iBoxx ALBI India Index, a composite of local currency bonds, joined the global bond sell-off with a loss of 1% for the month. U.S. dollar denominated Indian debt fared even worse, with the iBoxx ADBI India
