Subject: Notice of Offer for Sale (OFS) of 6,06,665 Equity Shares ("Shares") of Rs. 10/- each of YKM Industries Limited (Scrip Code: 531260) by Promoter namely Mr. Anil Jain through the Stock Exchange Mechanism (the "OFS Notice")

Pursuant to Clause 5(b) of the SEBI Circular No. CIR/MRD/DP/18/2012 dated July 18, 2012, as amended by circulars nos. CIR/MRD/DP/04/2013 dated January 25, 2013, CIR/MRD/DP/17/2013 dated May 30,2013,CIR/MRD/DP/24/2014 dated August 8, 2014, CIR/MRD/DP/31/2014 dated December 1 2014, CIR/MRD/DP/12/2015 dated June 26, 2015 and CIR/MRD/DP/36/2016 dated February 15, 2016 ("SEBI OFS Circulars") issued by Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI) pertaining to comprehensive guidelines on offer for sale through stock exchange mechanism, we wish to inform you that Mr. Anil Jain, a part of the promoter group of YKM Industries Limited (the "Company"), being the selling promoter member proposes to sell 6,06,665 equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each representing 13.51% of the share capital of the Company on Friday, December 28, 2018 ("T" day) for Non-Retail Investors and on Monday, December 31st , 2018 ("T+1" day) for Retail Investors and for Non-Retail Investors who choose to carry forward their bids through a sale on the separate window provided by BSE Limited in accordance with (i) SEBI OFS Circular (ii) Notice No. 20120727-26 dated July 27, 2012, Notice No. 20130129-23 dated January 29, 2013, Notice No. 20140902-33 dated September 2, 2014, Notice no. 20150122-30 dated January 22, 2015 and Notice No. 20150702-28 dated July 2, 2015 issued by BSE Limited (the "Sale").

Other important information in relation to the Sale is set out below under the heading "Important Information", and the information included therein forms an integral part of the terms and conditions of the Sale. Allocation Methodology

The allocation shall be at or above the Floor Price (defined below) on price priority basis at multiple clearing prices, in accordance with the SEBI OFS Circulars, except in case of the Retail Investors (defined below), who shall have an option to bid at or above the Cut-Off Price (defined below)

10% of the Sale size shall be reserved for allocation to the Retail Investors (defined below) (the "Retail Category"). Bidders can bid under Retail Category or other than Retail Category ("Non-Retail Category"). The Stock Exchange will decide the quantity of shares eligible to be considered in the Retail Category, based on the Floor Price (defined below) declared by the Seller.

Indicative price for the Non-Retail category shall be displayed separately. There shall be no indicative price for the Retail Category.

No single bidder other than mutual funds registered with the Securities and Exchange Board of India under the SEBI (Mutual Funds) Regulations, 1996 and insurance companies registered with the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority under the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority Act, 1999 shall be allocated more than 25% of the sale shares being offered in the Sale.

on T+1 day in accordance with the SEBI OFS Circulars.

The allocation to the Non-Retail Investors shall be at price equal to the Cut-Off Price or higher as per the bids.

The allocation shall be at or above the Floor Price (defined below) on price priority method at multiple clearing prices in accordance with the SEBI OFS Circulars

A minimum of 25% of the shares in the Sale shall be reserved for mutual funds registered with the Securities and Exchange Board of India under the SEBI (Mutual Funds) Regulations, 1996 and insurance companies registered with the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority under the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority Act, 1999, subject to receipt of valid bids/orders at or above the Floor Price and as per allocation methodology.

In the event of any under subscription by mutual funds and insurance companies, the unsubscribed portion shall be available to the other bidders.

Retail Category Allocation Methodology

- Retail Investor shall mean individual investor who places bids for shares of total value of not more than ` 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lacs Only) aggregated across exchanges ("Retail Investor").
