The Board is of the view that having regard to the cash flows that the Company has been able to consistently

Long-term motor insurance policies to provide flexibility

MITHUN DASGUPTA Kolkata, December 8

Irdai has proposed to permit general insurers to sell longterm motor insurance policies, industry insiders said the move would provide freedom and flexibility to the customer and help insurers take motor insurance products to the masses.

Floating an exposure draft on 'Long-Term Motor Products covering both Motor Third Party Insurance and Own Damage Insurance', the regulator has proposed three-year policies for private cars co-terminus with motor third party liability cover, and five-year policies for twowheelers also co-terminus with motor third party liability cover.

The regulator has also proposed long-term own damage cover in case of renewal of standalone own damage poliyear policies for certain class of commercial vehicles (ambu-

Earlier, general insurance companies were allowed to offer long-term cover for both motor third party insurance and own damage insurance for three years (new cars) or five years (new two-wheelers). Additionally, standalone own damage covers were also introduced for cars and two-wheelers, both

new and old. But, Irdai had decided to withdraw the longterm package covers offered for three years or five years for new cars and new two-wheelers, respectively, effective from August 1, 2020.



- (b) Enhance overall shareholders value; and

11 MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS ON THE LIKELY IMPACT OF THE BUYBACK ON THE COMPANY

11.1 The Buyback is expected to enhance overall long term members' value for continuing members, without compromising on the future growth opportunities of the Company, as well as provide an exit opportunity to the public shareholders. The Buyback is not likely to cause any material adverse impact on the earnings of the Company, except a reduction in the treasury income which the Company could have otherwise earned from

investments.
