NOTICE is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 and other applicable provisions if any of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") as amended from time to time read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the "SEBI Listing Regulations"), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings ("SS-2") issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India (including any Statutory modification(s) or reenactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) and in accordance with guidelines prescribed by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") for inter-alia conducting Postal Ballot through remote e-voting vide General Circular No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, 22/2020 dated 15th June, 2020, 33/2020 dated 28th September, 2020, 39/2020 dated 31st December, 2020, 10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, 20/2021 dated 08th December, 2021, 03/2022 dated May 5, 2022, 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 and General Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023, (collectively called as "MCA Circulars") and other applicable provisions of the Act, rules, circulars and notifications issued there under, that the resolution set out below are proposed to be passed as Special Business through the mechanism of postal ballot process through voting by electronic means ('remote e-voting') in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Act 2013 and rules made there under.

Further, the Company will send Postal Ballot Notice by email to all its shareholders who have registered their email addresses with the Company / RTA or Depository / Depository Participants and the communication of assent/dissent of the members will only take place through the remote e-voting system.

The Statement pertaining to the said resolution setting out the material facts and the reasons for proposing the same are annexed herewith for your consideration and approval.

In accordance with the provisions of the MCA Circulars, the Company is sending Postal Ballot Notice in electronic form only. Hence, hard copy of Postal Ballot Notice along with Postal Ballot form and pre-paid business reply envelop will not be sent to the members for this Postal Ballot process and members are required to communicate their assent or dissent through the remote e-voting facility. In compliance with Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the rules framed there under and MCA Circulars, the Company has extended the remote e-voting facility for its members, to enable them to cast their votes electronically. The members can vote on resolution through remote e-voting facility. Assent or dissent of the members on the resolution mentioned in the Postal Ballot Notice would be taken through the remote e-voting system as per the MCA Circulars.

Members desiring to exercise their vote are requested to carefully follow the instructions stated in the notes under section "The Instruction for the members for remote e-voting" appended with this Postal Ballot Notice and cast their votes not later than 5:00 P.M. (IST) on Tuesday, 25th day of June, 2024.

The Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on Wednesday, 15th May, 2024 has appointed Mr. L.N. Joshi, Practicing Company Secretary, Indore (Membership Number F-5201, Certificate of Practice Number 4216), as Scrutinizer for conducting the Postal Ballot process through Remote e-voting in a fair and transparent manner. Further, the Company has engaged Central Depository Services India Limited ('CDSL') to provide remote e-voting facility to the Equity Shareholders of the Company.

The Scrutinizer after completion of the scrutiny will submit the report to the Chairman or any authorized person of the Company. - 8. Voting right in e-voting cannot be exercised by a proxy. However, corporate and institutional members shall be entitled to vote through their authorized representative with proof of their authorization.

During this period shareholders' of the Company, as on the cut-off date Friday, 17th May, 2024 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- (ii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step 1: Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

(iii) In terms of SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020 on e-voting facility provided by Listed Companies, individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants.
