INDIA bloc to disintegrate after June 4: PM at UP rally

Phrases such as "Trinamool Congress (brand of) politics" and "bua-babua (aunt-nephew) bonhomie", a reference to the political equation between West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and Samajwadi Party's Akhilesh Yadav made its debut in Uttar Pradesh's political discourse on Thursday.

Addressing a rally in Bhadohi, where the Opposition alliance fielded a Trinamool Congress candidate, Prime Minister Narendra Modi cautioned the electorate to be wary of the Opposition's attempt to dish out the "Trinamool (brand of) politics" in UP, which he alleged involved harassing women, Dalits and the murder of Hindus. In his public meeting in Pratapgarh, the PM accused the SP and Congress of issuing an appeal for "vote jihad" against Modi.

He predicted that the INDIA (Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance) would disintegrate after June 4.

If Trinamool's politics became an issue that the PM flagged in UP, in Bengal's Tamluk, addressing a public meeting, Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee clarified her statement made on Wednesday that her party would extend outside support to the opposition front INDIA after it comes to power.

"At the all-India level, some people have misunderstood my statement yesterday. I am very much part of the INDIA alliance. The INDIA alliance was my brainchild. We are together at the

national level and will continue to be together," she said.

Banerjee alleged that the West Bengal units of both CPI(M) and Congress, who are part of the INDIA alliance, have joined hands and helped the BJP in the state, a comment made with an eye on the 2026 Assembly polls in Bengal.

On Wednesday, Banerjee had said her party would give outside support to an INDIA alliance government, which was construed to mean that she was no longer part of the alliance.

In UP, the PM ridiculed the SP-TMC alliance.

"The previous bua (hinting at Mayawati) identified the SP people and left them. They have now brought a bua (aunt) from Bengal (a reference to

Banerjee)," the PM said. The SP and BSP had an alliance for the 2019 Lok Sabha polls. Modi said a game of bua and babua (referring to Akhilesh Yadav) is going on.

He said that Akhilesh Yadav should ask his "bua" why she calls people from UP and Bihar outsiders.

In Bhadohi, the BJP's Vinod Kumar Bind is pitted against Lalitesh Pati Tripathi of the TMC and Harishankar of the BSP.

At his public meeting in Jaunpur, the PM said people would earlier talk of Delhi and Mumbai when discussing development, but now the country and the world talk about Kashi-Ayodhya. "Modi and Yogi are going to change the picture and fate of Purvanchal over the next five years," he added.

JD(S) MLA HD Revanna gets interim bail in sexual assault case

A court on Thursday granted interim bail to JD(S) MLA and former Karnataka Minister H D Revanna in a sexual harassment case.

The case of sexual harassment of a 47-year-old house help was registered against Revanna and his son and MP Prajwal Revanna at the Holenarsipur town police station in Hassan district on April 28. Prajwal reportedly left for Germany on April 27 and is still at large.

The complainant had claimed that the father-son duo had sexually abused her at the 66-year-old MLA's house.

The Special Investigation Team which is probing the alleged sexual abuse charges against Prajwal, had sought custody of the former minister.

Press broom symbol & I won't need to go back to jail: Kejriwal

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday urged people to vote for AAP if they don't want him to return to jail.

Holding a roadshow in Punjab's Amritsar for the party's candidate Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal, the AAP supremo also claimed that the BJP will end reservation for SC, ST and OBC if it gets a majority in the Lok Sabha.

Referring to the BJP, Kejriwal said saffron party leaders are saying he will have to go to jail after 20 days.

"Whether I go (back) to jail or not depends upon you. If you press the 'jhadoo' (AAP's election symbol) button, I will not need to go to jail," Kejriwal said. On May 10, the apex court granted Kejriwal interim bail till June 1.

PoK belongs to India, will take it back at any cost: Amit Shah

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Thursday asserted that Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) belongs to India and the country will take it back "at any cost".

Addressing election rallies in Bihar's Sitamarhi and Madhubani Lok Sabha constituencies, the former BJP president claimed that the Congress-led INDIA bloc was planning to rotate the PM's chair among its constituents if voted to power.

"When Article 370 was scrapped, Rahul Gandhi had said that it would lead to bloodshed. Five years have elapsed and not a pebble has been hurled. But Congress ally Farooq Abdullah tries scaremongering by saying that we cannot take back PoK as Pakistan has atom bombs," Shah said at Sitamarhi.

No exception made in granting interim bail to Kejriwal: SC to ED

AAP chief refused to comment on Maliwal as police record latter's statement

The Supreme Court said Thursday that it has not made any exception for Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal in granting him interim bail for campaigning in the Lok Sabha polls and "critical analysis of the judgment is welcome".

A bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Dipankar Datta refused to consider claims and counters of the Enforcement Directorate (ED) and Kejriwal's lawyer on statements made related to the interim bail to the Aam Aadmi Party national convener.

"We have not made any exception for anybody, we said in our order what we felt was justified," the bench said, adding that critical analysis of the judgment is "welcome".

The events at the court takes place even as the Delhi Police recorded the statement of AAP MP Swati Maliwal on Thursday in connection with the alleged assault on her by an aide of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, even as the BJP hit out at the AAP supremo for maintaining silence over the incident.

Bibhav Kumar, the personal assistant of Kejriwal, has also been summoned by the National Commission for

Women (NCW) on Friday over the matter. Appearing for the ED, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta objected to Kejriwal's speeches in poll rallies that if people voted for AAP, he would not have to go back to prison on June 2.

Meanwhile, the Aam Aadmi Party convener addressed a press conference earlier in the day at Lucknow with Samajwadi Party leader Akhilesh Yadav where the Delhi chief minister was asked about the incident. AAP chief Arvind Kejriwal refused comment on the Swati Maliwal 'assault' at a joint press conference on Thursday where Akhilesh Yadav said there are "more important things" to discuss.

AAP leader Sanjay Sing, also present at the press con-

ference, said there should be no politics on the issue.

He then targeted the BJP government and raised the issue of a Manipuri woman being paraded naked, the Prajwal Revanna sex scandal and Maliwal being 'beaten' up by police during protests by wrestlers when she was the Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) chief.

Sanjay Singh said the BJP and Prime Minister Narendra Modi should answer for atrocities against women during the party rule.

"The entire country is sad till date that wife of a Kargil veteran was paraded naked in Manipur and the PM of India remained silent. Prajwal Revanna raped thousands of women and he was allowed to flee from the country by the

will file complaint against Kejriwal, AAP: ED to SC

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) Thursday told the Supreme Court (SC) it will soon file a prosecution complaint against Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) in a money laundering case related to the alleged excise policy scam.

Appearing for the ED, Additional Solicitor General SV Raju told a bench of Justices Sanjiv Khanna and Dipankar Datta, "We are proposing to file the prosecution complaint (charge sheet) against Arvind Kejriwal and AAP. We will do it shortly. It is in the pipeline." The statements were made by the ED during the hearing on Kejriwal's plea against his arrest.
