Rajasthan: 4 die after consuming illicit liquor, second such tragedy this month

Jaipur, Four people died and six others were hospitalised after they consumed illicit liquor in Rajasthan's Bhiwara district on Friday, a police officer said. This is the second such tragedy in the state this month. Seven people died after having illicit liquor in the

Bharatpur district of the state over two weeks back. Additional police superintendent Gajendra Singh said three policemen, including the local police station in-charge of Mandalgari, have been suspended over the Bhiwara tragedy. Chief minister Ashok Gehlot expressed grief over the loss of lives and announced financial assistance of ₹2 lakh each to the families of the four and ₹50,000 each to six hospitalised people. Seven excise officials were also suspended while authorities ordered an inquiry over the matter.

Bihar youth gets 20 years jail term for raping minor

Patna, A special Pocos court on Friday sentenced a sixth additional district and session court in Bihar's Ara city on Thursday awarded 20 years rigorous imprisonment to a youth for raping an eight year old minor girl in April 2019, said a law officer. The court had found the accused guilty on January 20 this year and the quantum of sentence was announced on Thursday. The judge also imposed a fine of ₹25,000 on the guilty. The fine will be handed over to

Both the survivor and the convict are residents of a village situated under Hasan Bazar post police station, said special public prosecutor Saroj Kumari. According to the case report, the convict and her family had threatened the survivor's family, after the minor was raped at her house on April 19, 2019, to not lodge an FIR or else suffer the consequences. The mother of the survivor, however, lodged a complaint at the Ara Mahila police station. Court had framed charges against the convict on August 19 the same year. Prosecution produced six witnesses during the trial.

UP to cover 4.80 lakh health workers in 3rd and 4th round of Covid vaccination

Lucknow, The Uttar Pradesh government plans to cover 4.80 lakh healthcare workers in the third and fourth rounds in the Covid-19 vaccination drive, to be carried out across the state on January 28 and 29 respectively. The state health and family welfare department could 2.60 lakh healthcare workers will be vaccinated during 2,303 sessions between 9 am to 5 pm on January 28; whereas, 2.20 lakh healthcare workers will be given the vaccine doses in 2,100 vaccine sessions organised in the districts on January 29 during the same hours. CM Yogi Adityanath has asked for the completion of healthcare workers' vaccination on schedule, said additional chief secretary, information, Navneet Sehgal. The state government has

decided to cover vaccination for all healthcare workers in the state on four days- January 28 and 29, February 4 and 5. The vaccination of the frontline workers will commence from February 11. During Covid vaccination drive held on January 16, the health department could vaccinate 22,643 healthcare

workers against the target of 31,700. Again on January 22, 1.01 lakh health workers were given vaccine jabs against the target of 1.50 lakh. The health workers who missed the dose in the earlier two rounds can avail the job in the coming rounds. Before the launch of the first round of vaccination on January 16, Uttar

Pradesh had received a consignment of 1,055,500 Covishield and 20,000 Covaxin doses. Additional chief secretary, health and family welfare, Amit Mohan Prasad said the health department has completed preparations for completing the vaccination of the healthcare workers in four rounds.
