We did not audit the financial statements of five subsidiaries included in the consolidated financial results, whose financial statements reflect total assets of Rs. 6,101.43 Lacs as at March 31, 2024 and total revenues of Rs. 2,257.98 Lacs and Rs. 9,089.46 Lacs for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024 respectively, total net profit after tax of Rs. 86.71 Lacs and net profit after tax of Rs. 424.68 Lacs for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024 respectively and total comprehensive income of Rs. 90.54 Lacs and total comprehensive income of Rs. 432.38 for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2024 respectively and net cash inflows (net) of Rs. (8.94) for the year ended March 31, 2024, as considered in the Statement. These financial statements/ financial information have been audited by other auditors whose reports have been furnished to us by the Management and our opinion and conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries and associates, is based solely on the reports of the other auditors and the procedures performed by us as stated under Auditor's Responsibilities section above.

Our report on the Statement is not modified in respect of the above matters.
