EXIM company owner booked in ₹1.39 crore cheating case

Pydhonie police have booked the owner of an export / import firm for allegedly cheating a jewellery-maker businessman out of Rs1.39

Juzar Anguthiwala, owner of Al-Hind Import and Export, for allegedly took material from Ankur Antala and did not pay for them. Antala filed a case against him on Wednes-

According to the police report, Antala operates an imitation jewellery business in Rajkot known as Prachi Imitation Company. Since 2016, Prachi Imitation Company has been supplying jewellery to Al-Hind Import and Export, which is located on AE Patel Marg in Pydhonie. Anguthiwala had been regularly paying Antala for the materials, earning his trust. As a result, Antala supplied materials from his own company and from another company to Anguthiwala.

However, after a few months, Anguthiwala stopped paying Antala, leading to an outstanding amount in crores. Antala met with Anguthiwala to request payment but to no avail. Subsequently, Antala sent a legal notice to Anguthiwala regarding the Rs1.39 crore owed but received no response.

Antala discovered that Anguthiwala sold the jewellery to other companies and received payments for them but did not settle his dues with Antala. In November 2023, when Antala contacted Anguthiwala, he was verbally abused and told to send a notice.

Ultimately, Antala filed a case against Anguthiwala under Indian Penal Code sections 409 (criminal breach of trust by merchant) and 420 (cheating and dishonesty).

Coal scam: Jail for top directors

ADelhi court on Thursday awarded three-year and twoyear jail terms to two directors of a Maharashtra-based company in a case related to irregularities in the allocation of a coal block in the state. Special Judge Sanjay Bansal imposed a fine of Rs50 lakh on the company, BS Ispat, besides awarding three-year jail term to Mohan Agrawal, 73, and two-year imprisonment to Rakesh Agrawal, 49, who is Mohan's nephew. The judge also imposed a fine of Rs 10 lakh each on both them. They were held quilty under sections 420 (cheating) and 120-B (criminal conspiracy) of the IPC by the

A 30-year-old man who did not know the whereabouts of his seven-year-old son was one day scrolling through a social networking site when he came across a bhajan video, in which the child was a participant. Only then did he come to know that his estranged wife, who had left home along with their son, had admitted the child to a Shrila Prabhupada Ashram, stating that she voluntarily wished to put him on 'bhakti

The Bombay High Court recently ordered the ashram to hand over the custody of the child to his father.

Srikant Tambe (name changed), a resident of Mira Road, had married the love of his life, Anjali Mishra (name

change) in 2014. Anjali delivered a baby boy in 2016, but soon differences started occurring between the couple.

In 2022, Anjali decided to leave her matrimonial house along with her son and proceeded to her maternal house in Uttar Pradesh. Whenever Tambe asked to speak to his child, he was told that he was unavailable

In December 2022, when Tambe was strolling through some social networking sites, he came across a video posted by the Shrila Prabhupada Ashram, in which his son was seen chanting bhajans.

"Initially I was not able to recognise my son, as his head was shaved off and he was wearing some dhoti. However, my family confirmed my child's identity. I immediately rushed to Ud-

Advocate Vishal Khetre, Tambe's lawyer, who is also associated with the NGO 'Dard Se Hamdard Tak', said, "Srikant approached me seeking some remedy to get his son back, and I thought of filing a habeas corpus before the Bombay High Court. Accordingly, in May 2023, we filed for it. The court then directed the ashram authorities to appear before it along with the child. I informed the court that the child was taken away from the legal guardian without seeking his permission,

which was illegal.'

Khetre also informed the court that the ashram was not ready to hand over the child, as Mehta had told them that she was a single parent and was not able to take care of the child. "It was surprising for us as Anjali had voluntarily taken away the child and later refused to take responsibility, despite the fact that Srikant was well off," he said.

The court presided over by Justice Revati Mohite Dere and Justice Gauri Godse decided to call the child into their chamber and ask for his opinion.

"When the boy was produced, he started searching for his 'Baba' and hugged him and cried. The child informed the court that he does not wish to go back to the ashram, but wishes to stay with his 'Baba'," Khetre added.
