One held under POCSCO in Sivasagar

Assam Rising, Sivasagar, May 14: One Suraj Rajak of Samastipur Bihar, was arrested by Sivasagar Police under Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act 2019 (Amendment) CrP, Article 376 on Monday following an FIR in Sivasagar PS by the parents of two victim children aged 4 & 5. According to reports, the accused, a laundry worker in Sivasagar town, lived in a rented house in Rang ghar Chariali near the victim's family. He had been sexually abusing the two little girls for a long period by enticing them with sweets and chocolates till they complained of acute pain to their parents. He was produced before the Magistrate and sent to jail. Monica Saikia, a leading women activist of the state, condemned the incident and demanded exemplary punishment while Indran Rajkumar, general secretary, Sadoua Aom Mohila Samity, demanded capital punishment for the low criminal.

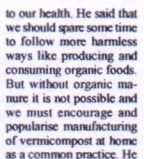

Workshop on Vermicomposting held at THB College

Assam Rising, Biswanath Chariali, May 14: A day long workshop on Vermicomposting was held there at Tyagbir Hem Baruah College under the aegis of Eco Club and Boyat department of the college with participation of more than one hundred students from the Higher Secondary and High Schools of the greater Naduar area. Delivering the welcome address Dr. Aji Hazarika, Principal of the college told that vermicomposting may open up before our students a new career and they can adopt it along with their studies and try to be self-reliant. He said that such training programmes may stimulate our students to consider the most benign ways of living and search for alternate means of livelihood. Dr. Ratul Nath, Assistant Professor, Behali Degree College acting as the resource person spoke extensively on the topic and narrated how a person can materialise the dream of becoming a crorepati simply by following such a very humble career of producing vermicompost at home with very low investment. He described how unwise use of pesticides and chemicals are destroying the crop fields and posing a threat



to our health. He said that we should spare some time to follow more harmless ways like producing and consuming organic foods. But without organic manure it is not possible and we must encourage and popularise manufacturing of vermicompost at home as a common practice. He told that our students may associate themselves with this process and pursue a very lucrative career. Later a hands-on training on vermicomposting was conducted at the Vermicompost Production and Training Centre of the college and Pankaj Hazarika, an award-winning farmer and expert in Vermicompost offered necessary training in this regard. Previously Dr. Tuli Upadhyaya explaining the objectives of the programme said that man has done much damage to nature by overexploiting the natural resources and it is high time to take responsibility towards our environment. Under Mission Life Assam a number of programmes have been conducted to sensitise the people regarding the environmental issues and the present workshop organised by Assam Sci-

ence Technology and Environment Council and sponsored by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, government of India is part of that objective which may encourage our students to adopt more eco-friendly ways for survival. The programme was presided over by Dr. Bipul Kumar Borah, President of the Governing Body

of the college. He expected that such programmes would motivate our students to think about our ailing environment and follow innovative and harmless means of livelihood. The programme was anchored by Manisha Das, assistant Professor, department of Botany.

Former MP Ishwar Prasanna Hazarika passes away

Assam Rising, Tezpur, May 14: Ishwar Prasanna Hazarika former Member of Parliament from the Tezpur Lok Sabha constituency and an Indian Civil Servant passed away on Monday morning at Fortis Escorts Heart Institute in New Delhi. He breathed his last at 88 due to prolonged heart ailment and associated complications. He was elected to the Lok Sabha, from the Tezpur constituency in 1996 as a member of the Indian National Congress. As an Indian Civil Servant Hazarika served in different key positions in his service career. He served as Chairman and Managing Director of MMTTC, Director on the Board of NTPC, Chairman of ASEP, Income Tax Commissioner and key positions in GAIL, SAIL, before shifting to his political life. Born on January 22, 1937 to freedom fighter Tirtheswar Hazarika and Mokshada Devi at Lakhimpur

district of Assam, meritorious student late Hazarika pursued his college education at Cotton College, Banaras Hindu University and the Delhi School of Economics. He also held a Barrister Degree from the United Kingdom. Different organizations and individuals including Dadul Borkakati, president, Sonitpur district congress committee, senior congress leader of Sonitpur Madhurjya Goswami, MLA Tezpur Prithiraj Rabha, former MLA Tezpur Brindaban Goswami, Vice Chairman, Amitron Rihbaran Sarma and several others have deeply mourned at the death of the former MP Hazarika. Among many disciples he leaves behind his wife Chaya Hazarika, two sons and a daughter and a score of grieving relatives
