Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations, we wish to inform you that Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Limited ("**DCBL**"), wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, has received order on January 24, 2024, under Section 85 of The Finance Act, 1994 (Service Tax), wherein:

- (1) service tax demand of Rs 52.36 Lacs has been dropped and;
- (2) confirmed the demand of:
 - (i) Service Tax of Rs 3.93 Lacs on Import of Services from outside India along with interest;
 - (ii) Service Tax on disallowance of CENVAT Credit of Rs 0.62 Lacs along with interest; and
 - (iii) Penalty amount of Rs. 4.23 Lacs.

DCBL has a good case on merits to defend the aforesaid demand before the Appellate Authorities and shall file an appeal against the said order before the CESTAT, New Delhi within prescribed timelines.

The details as required under Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI circular dated SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 are provided in the Annexure hereto.
