




- 3 Plants located in UP-India's largest sugar producing state



Increased Farmer Bonding


- Associated with around 1,13,000 farmer families

- Regular farmer interaction through 'Kisan Goshthi' and 'Nukkad Natak'










Sugar - Quarter Performance







Sugar – Half-Year Performance





Distillery - Quarter Performance






Distillery – Half-Year Performance





