Subject: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015 ("LODR Regulations").

In continuation of our earlier disclosures dated December 1, 2023, December 15, 2023, December 29, 2023, January 6, 2024, January 31, 2024 and February 22, 2024 we write to inform you that the Company had filed a Special Leave Petition (**SLP**) challenging the findings given in the Hon'ble Bombay High Court order dated February 22, 2024 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has heard and disposed the SLP on March 22, 2024 and observed that since the challenge in the writ petition filed in Bombay High Court was to the orders of the Principal Bench of NGT, they are of the view that the Petitioner would have remedies against the order of the NGT in appeal. Further, the Hon'ble Supreme Court *clarified* that the observations contained in the impugned order will not come in the way of the recourse to the appellate remedies for the Petitioner.

The said order was signed & uploaded on March 25, 2024 During the course of the hearing before the Supreme Court, a statement was made by the Senior Counsel appearing for Gujarat Pollution Control Board ("GPCB") that no coercive steps will be taken by them against the Company, for the next three weeks from the date of the order i.e. March 22, 2024, within which time the Company will file its appeal and take other measures as advised.
