Court rejects accused's bail plea in cop's murder case

New Delhi: A Delhi court Monday dismissed a bail application of an accused in the murder case of Head Constable Ratan Lal during the communal violence in north east Delhi in February, saying he was a flight risk.

Additional Sessions Judge Vinod Yadav said the call detail record of accused Shadab Ahmad showed that he was in constant touch with proclaimed offenders and co-accused in the case of Suleman Siddiqui and Ravish.

The charges against the applicant are serious in nature. The applicant (Ahmad) is not the resident of Delhi and as such, he would be a flight risk, the court said.

The court said that a strange thing has been noticed from Ahmad's call detail records (CDR) that around

the time of the murder of the head constable, his location was around the spot of the incident and he had received three calls from his counsel who was representing him in the matter.

It could be a coincidence, but not without significance. I will refrain from commenting as to whether it was morally or ethically appropriate for the learned counsel to have represented the applicant (Ahmad) in the matter, it said in its order.

It further said a perusal of his CDRs from January 31, 2020, to February 24, 2020, revealed that he was in touch with some of the co-accused persons in the murder case as well in the matter related to the larger conspiracy in the riots, which was being investigated by the Special Cell of the Delhi police.

Ahmad has also been arrested in the conspiracy case.

The court noted that though Ahmad has not been seen in any of the CCTV footage collected by the police, he has been categorically identified by independent public witnesses and police officials in their statements recorded under section 161 (examination by police) Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC).

The court observed that it was clearly evident from CCTV footage and statements of witnesses, that the protestors and organizers had motivated the persons in the mob and certain unscrupulous elements had surrounded the scene of crime and they appeared to be well equipped with rioting material like stones, sticks, sharp-edged weapons and other sort



of raw weapons.

Even burqa-clad women are clearly seen attacking the police party with sticks and other material in their hands and they clearly appeared to be charged up. It has also come on record that some of the persons of the mob had taken possession of the rooftops of high-rise buildings at or around 25 feet road, having firearms and other rioting material with them.

All this prima facie indicates that everything was being done under a well-hatched conspiracy, the common object whereof was to cause blockade

any CCTV footage or his CDR location, which could prima facie show his presence at the scene of crime on the date of the incident, his counsel further said.

Special Public Prosecutor Amit Prasad, appearing for the police, opposed the bail plea saying Ahmad used to share stage with other protestors and instigate the gathering against the Government of India which ultimately led to violence on February 24, thereby resulting in death of more than 50 people in north-east Delhi, including Lal.

The public prosecutor further argued that Ahmad may be residing at Jagatpuri, but he used to take part in the protest against the Citizenship Amendment Act and the National Register for Citizens and used to come to Chand

Bagh which is about 10 kilometers from his residence.

Prasad said that Ahmad was in constant touch with other accused persons and on the day of incident, he had reached at the scene of crime just before the eruption of the communal riots in the area.

He further argued that the case was peculiar, wherein the protectors of the life and liberty of the general public were beaten black and blue by the so called protestors under a large-scale conspiracy and the accused was a part of it.

Communal clashes had broken out in northeast Delhi on February 24 after violence between citizenship law supporters and protesters spiralled out of control, leaving at least 53 people dead and around 200 injured.

Delhi to deploy 2,500 environment marshals to spread awareness about anti-pollution campaign

New Delhi: The Delhi Government will deploy 2,500 environment marshals across the city to generate awareness about its recently launched anti-pollution campaign, "Red Light On, Gaadi Off", Environment Minister Gopal Rai said on Monday.

These marshals will be deployed at 100 traffic signals across Delhi's 11 districts, he said.



Addressing reporters, Rai said the shortlisted traffic signals are those where the red light is two-minute long.

"From October 21 to November 15, a ground-level awareness drive on 'Red Light On, Gaadi Off' campaign will be launched at 100 traffic signals. We are in the process of appointing 2,500 environment marshals who will spread awareness about the campaign at these signals. It is an awareness drive, not an enforcement drive," he said.

Rai said local SDM and traffic police (ACP) will monitor this campaign and if required, transport department's deputy commissioner (enforcement) will also oversee the campaign.

extra 200 for the 10 slightly bigger in size. 300 marshals have been kept as reserve in case of need," Rai said.

He said the Delhi government will write to all MPs, MLAs, councillors, RWAs, industrial and other social agencies to take part in this campaign.

This campaign will be effective from morning 8 am till evening 8 pm. For this, Transport and Traffic police have identified and submitted a list of a select group of 100 major traffic points from 11 districts, he said.

"The marshals will adopt the principle of 'Gandhigiri'. They will give red roses to those not switching off the ignition at red lights. They will be made aware as to why it is important for them to do it and how they can fight pollution through the move," he added.

The "Red Light On, Gaadi Off" campaign was launched by Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on October 15.

Experts say on an average a vehicle stops at a red light for 15-20 minutes in a day, consuming 200 ml of fuel, creating pollution.

If 10 lakh vehicles switch off ignition at red lights, 1.5 tons of PM10 and 0.4 tons of PM2.5 will be prevented every year, they said.

Yogi clears way for more than 2L jobs for rural youth

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath cleared ways for more than two lakh jobs for rural youth of the State after dedicating more than 18,000 panchayat bhawans and public toilets in rural areas with the click of the mouse.

While 18,847 public toilets and 377 panchayat bhawans were dedicated for public use, Yogi Adityanath also directed officials to complete another 35,058 public toilets and 21,414 panchayat bhawans in the next six months.

The chief minister also directed officials to start the process for appointment of caretakers and sanitation workers for panchayat bhawans and public toilets.

"The appointment will be on contractual basis and local youth will be given priority, thus creating jobs for them in a large-scale," the chief minister said. Besides, as many as 59,000 rural women would also be appointed as bank correspondent Sakhi at gram panchayats and they would operate from panchayat bhawans, facilitating bank services to people.

More job opportunities are expected to be created for tech-savvy rural youth as panchayat bhawans are being connected through optical fibre.

UP Govt to now focus on post-Covid complications

Apprehending a second wave of COVID-19 infection due to relaxations across the state, the Uttar Pradesh government has decided to focus on recovered patients in their post-treatment complications.

In an order issued on Monday, the government has directed all government and private hospitals to set up post-Covid help desks for patients who have recovered from the infection but face other complications.

Additional Chief Secretary (Health) Amit Mohan Prasad said in Lucknow on Monday that the Health department officials would telephonically contact about 80,000 patients who recovered between September 1 and 15 to get feedback on any possible complications.

Prasad said that the government had inputs that several recovered patients were facing health complications.

"We have decided to address these issues and experts have been engaged to check them to learn why such things were happening," he said.

Speaking on the drop in COVID-19 positivity rate in UP, the additional chief secretary said that between March and May 31, the positivity rate was 3.3 percent which spiked to 4 percent in June, 4.2 percent in July and 4.6 percent in August.

UP crosses MGNREGA job target in six months

Expressing satisfaction over job creation under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that MGNREGA generated record employment in rural areas and helped in reviving the local economy during the coronavirus pandemic.

"The UP government set a target to generate 26 crore man days during the pandemic this fiscal and we generated 26.16 crore man days' work in just six months. This is an indicator of our commitment towards generating employment at village level," the chief minister said in Lucknow on Monday.

"Various works under this scheme were taken up in villages, including revival of rivers and water bodies and plantation of trees. Migrant workers returning from other states played an active role in this project," Yogi said. Officials said that the UP government also gave jobs to over 65 lakh workers in MGNREGA schemes amid the pandemic through rural job guarantee scheme. The MGNREGA is the way by which people from rural areas are given employment of up to 100 days in a financial year. The nature of work is unskilled labour work.

These names and numbers of such persons have to be fixed and cannot change every day, the court said. The State DGP and Commissioner of Kolkata Police have to submit a report to the court within four days of Laxmi Puja which is on October 30. The order comes on the Tiritiya or the third day of the Pujas and is likely to go a distance in controlling the pandal hoppers who descend in lakhs on the city streets 24x7 every year during the pujas converting the City of Joy arguably into the biggest carnival on earth.

The Monday's decision comes two days after the same court delivered another judgment asking the State Government whether the grants of Rs 50,000 each to the puja committees was given for religious or secular purposes before directing the clubs to spend the amount only for secular purposes like distributing sanitisers, masks etc and file a detailed account report on such expenditures. Delivering the order, the Court asked if the students could be stopped from going to schools and colleges why then the State Government could not stop the mass pujas from taking place. Though most Trinamool Congress leaders many of who patronise their own pujas would not react some like Minister Subroto Mukherjee and Sujit Basu said "the order will cause some problem," adding however that they would abide by the order and take appropriate measures.

The top doctors including heart specialist Kunal Sarkar who had earlier jointly requested the people and the Government to stay off the pujas to avoid mass proliferation of corona pandemic, said, "Already Bengal is reporting high number of cases and after the pujas the figure may leap in geometrical proportion ... hence I request all the citizens with folded hands to abide by the High Court order."

Ganguly said there will be live telecast of aarti and devotees can offer "pushpanjali" from their homes with all rituals being live streamed. The size of Durga idol this year is just 5 ft, against the usual 12 to 14 ft every year, he added.

Purbanchal Bangiyo Samiti, an umbrella body of 38 Durga puja committees in East Delhi, said only 10 members of each committee will be allowed to have darshan at a time and they have to register their entry to the pandal so that contact-tracing can be easy.

"In view of the pandemic, Durga idol will be worshipped in 13 temples while 12 committees will organise only 'Kalash' puja," Samiti general secretary Mrinal K Biswas said, adding, "We have also decided to hire two priests due to

Covid-19. If the main priest gets infected, the other can perform the puja."

He said social-distancing will strictly be adhered to and people without face masks won't be allowed entry to the premises while alcohol-based hand sanitisers would be available both inside and outside temples.

Delhi Durga Puja Charitable and Cultural Committee in Kashmiri Gate, which claims to be organising Durga puja in the city for 111 years, will conduct virus test on the six labourers engaged in building pandals.

Committee general secretary Robin Bose said this time, they would conduct 'kalash' puja and entry of devotees will be very limited. The devotees will be encouraged to download the Aarogya Setu app in
