Doctors on the wheels to survive a patient

- A sick newborn, born with a birth defect called Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia, was transported from the referring hospital by our transport team.
- After 20 days of intensive neonatal care with continuation of high frequency ventilation with inhaled nitric oxide support, baby started showing response and was discharged on oral demand feeding.





4 year-old saved with air-lift support

- When a four-year-old child from Maharashtra met with a road traffic accident and suffered severe traumatic brain injury with a bleeding.
- The child needed an urgent neurosurgery as a lifesaving procedure. Rainbow Children Hospital, was approached for a safe airlift.
- The transport was done in co-ordination with the handing over and receiving teams by our experts.







Child with cut throat injury

- 2 years child presented with accidental injury to neck.
- Examination revealed complete transection of his windpipe. Child was rushed to the OT, tracheal repair was done.
- Child recovered uneventfully and discharged in 6 days.
- This case was managed by a multidisciplinary team involving surgeons, anesthesiologist and intensive care consultants.





International PICU Case

- A **5 years 7 months old child from Yemen** presented with fever, breathing difficulty, low oxygen levels and blood pressure, bleeding from mouth and stomach.
- Child was shifted to ward after 20 days of PICU stay.
 Child was discharged with oxygen after 37 days of hospital stay. He is taking oral feeds even with tracheostomy.

PICU ECMO Case

- 3-year-old child, presented with fever, cold & cough, fast breathing, dull activity and difficulty in breathing.
- Chest X-ray showed pneumonia on left side.
- Child was on ECMO for 9 days, and on ventilator for 2 days.
- After improving, child was discharged after 35 days of hospital stay.

Rainbow network comprises of 16 hospitals and 3 clinics in 6 cities, with a total bed capacity of 1,655 beds. Our Pediatric services under "Rainbow Children's Hospital" includes newborn and pediatric intensive care, pediatric multi-specialty services, pediatric quaternary care (including organ transplantation); whereas our women care services under "Birthright by Rainbow" offers perinatal care services which includes normal and complex obstetric care, multi-disciplinary fetal care, perinatal genetic and fertility care along with gynecology services.

Rainbow Children's hospital built on strong fundamentals of multidisciplinary approach with a full-time consultant led clinical service along with 24/7 commitment in a child centric environment. The company follows a hub-and-spoke operating model where the hub hospital provides comprehensive outpatient, inpatient care, with a focus on tertiary and quaternary services while the spokes provide emergency care in pediatrics and obstetrics, large outpatient services and comprehensive obstetrics, pediatric and level 3 NICU services. This model is successfully operational at Hyderabad and is gaining traction in Bengaluru. The endeavor is to replicate this approach in Chennai and across the National Capital Region. Subsequently Rainbow intends to expand into tier-2 cities of Southern India.

Rainbow embraces a unique doctor engagement model, where doctors work exclusively on a full-time, retainer basis. The doctors work in teams and have 24/7 commitment, which is particularly important for children's emergency, neonatal, pediatric intensive care services and to support pediatric retrieval services. The Company also operates the country's largest pediatric DNB training programme in private healthcare, offering post graduate residential DNB and fellowship programme.
