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The Board of Directors of Yash Management and Satellite Limited

Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results Opinion and Conclusion

We have (a) audited the quarterly standalone financial results of Yash Management & Satellite Limited (hereinafter referred to as the ("Company") for the quarter ended 31st March, 2024 and year to date results for the period from 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended (the "Listing Regulations")
