Shinde-BJP govt not serious about drought : Nana Patole

Mumbai, May 24 (UNI) : President of Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) Nana Patole on Friday demanded that the government should not hesitate under the pretext of code of conduct and should immediately provide fodder to animals, drinking water and work to the people in drought areas of state. Speaking to mediaperson at Nagpur, Patole said, "The drought situation in the state is very serious, some villages do not get water for months, there is no fodder for animals, no drinking water."

Mumbai, May 24 (UNI) : Maharashtra state assembly opposition leader Vijay Wadettiwar criticized the state government on Thursday, demanding that the government pay attention to the people's issues, including implementing measures for tackling the drought situation.

He said that the situation in the state is unseasonal rain on one side and drought on the other. He said that the entire state is suffering from drought. There is severe water scarcity, so both farmers and common people are suffering. Panchnama has not been done yet in places where there has been unseasonal rain. SC refuses to pass interim order to ECI on uploading voter

(Contd from page 1) the initial estimate announced on the voting day. ADR highlighted that the data published on April 30 showed a sharp increase (by about 5-6%) in the final voter turnout as compared to the initial percentages announced by ECI on the day of polling. This coupled with the delay in announcing the voter turnout led to concerns among voters and political parties about the correctness of such data, the plea said. The application was moved by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) in a 2019 case in which it had sought directions to the ECI to upload scanned, legible copies of Form 17C Part-I (Account of Votes Recorded), on its website.

The data should be updated after each phase of polling in the ongoing 2024 elections and must provide constituency and polling station-wise figures of voter turnout in absolute numbers and percentage form, the application stated. Additionally, ADR has sought disclosure of Part- II of Form 17C which contains the candidate-wise result of counting after the compilation of results.

ADR alleged that there has been a dereliction of duty on the part of the ECI in declaring election results through Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) based on accurate and indisputable data.

The ECI had in its reply contended that certain "vested interests" keep on throwing false allegations as to discredit its working.

The ECI alleged "There is a consistent malafide campaign/design/efforts to keep on raising suspicion and doubt in every possible manner and by misleading assertions and baseless allegations regarding the conduct of elections.... the design and pattern in play is to spread doubts and damage is done by the time the truth comes out," the ECI said.

Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar on Thursday, but 5 Guardian Ministers were absent from this meeting from which it is clear that the government is not serious about drought, he said. The Chief Minister should have given the order on the spot but only completed the task of the meeting. Patole further said that the government in the state is unconstitutional, and this government has nothing to do with the common people.

taking any measures," he added. 11 people were killed and 60 injured in an explosion at a chemical factory in Dombivli. After an earlier incident in Dombivli, the Maharashtra government had ordered the closure of these factories, but the corrupt coalition government that followed took money and kept the factories running, he alleged. Patole said it is the responsibility of the government to protect the lives of the people, but if the Khoke (Boxes) government does not care about the lives of the poor, the Shinde-BJP government should resign and be free, he added.

New schedule to hold Vidhan Parishad biennial election in Maharashtra announced : EC

Mumbai, May 24 (UNI) : The Election Commission of India (ECI) has announced the election schedule for the Maharashtra Legislative Council Teachers and Graduate Constituencies on Friday.

It may be noted that ECI had earlier announced election program on May 8 to hold election in four council constituencies on June 10 but due to objection by teachers' organisations in the backdrop of holiday it was deferred by the commission.

Now Election Commission on Friday issued fresh program to hold election to four seats namely Mumbai Graduate, Konkan Division Graduate, Nashik Division Teacher and Mumbai Teacher Constituency.

Vilas Vinayak Potnis (Mumbai Graduate Constituency), Niranjan Vasant Dawkhare (Konkan Graduate Constituency) Kishore Bhikaji Darade (Nashik Division Teachers Constituency) and Kapil Harishchandra Patil (Mumbai Teachers Constituency) are retiring from the Maharashtra Legislative Council on 7 July 2024.

As per new schedule, notification for this election will be issued on May 31.

Candidates can file applications for this election till June 7, 2024.

Scrutiny of the applications submitted by the candidates will be done on June 10, while the deadline for withdrawal of candidature is June 12.

Voting for these four constituencies will be held on June 26 from 8 am to 4 pm. Counting of votes will take place on July 1.

Shinde govt responsible for Dombivli blast: Danve

Mumbai, May 24 (UNI) : A major explosion took place at a chemical company in Dombivli, MIDC, on Thursday afternoon, resulting in the deaths of seven workers and injuring 48 others. Speaking to reporters Shiv Sena (UBT) group leader Ambadas Danave today held the Shinde government responsible for the explosion.

Danve, who inspected the incident site in Dombivli today, said that the Thackeray government had taken a decision to shift the chemical companies to another place. However, the Shinde government did not do anything about it," he alleged.

He further said that though it was not possible to shift the entire industrial area in Dombivli to another place, our MVA government had taken the decision that the five chemical companies that are here would be shifted from here to another place. However, unfortunately, our

government has gone and Shinde came to power and supported only unauthorized industries, Danve alleged.

He demanded that the state should have a policy on reactors. "Just as the state has a policy on boilers, it is necessary to have a policy on reactors. Because these reactors are old, even small companies can buy them, he added.

Meanwhile, Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis has refuted the allegations of Danave and said that no industry can be shifted in a day.

There has been a discussion that these industries should be shifted from one place to another. Uddhav Thackeray has not done anything for that. He has not filed a single file for that. However, considering the seriousness of this incident, another place should be made available to these industries, said Fadnis.

Mumbai court sentences step-father to death for murder

Mumbai, May 24 (UNI) : A Sessions Court in Mumbai on Friday awarded the death penalty to Parvez Tak, who was accused of sensationally killing his step-daughter and actress Laila Khan, her mother, three siblings, and a cousin sister in 2011.

Tak, a resident of Kashmir and the third husband of Khan's mother, Shelina, was arrested on July 8, 2012.

Fourteen years after the murders, the court found him guilty on May 9 for killing Laila, 30, her elder sister Azmina, 32, twin siblings Zara and Imran, 25, cousin Reshma, and Shelina, 51. Additional Sessions Judge S. B. Pawar, while awarding the death penalty, held in its order

that this is the rarest of the rare cases, hence the accused deserve the death penalty. Tak, the third husband of Saleena, the actress' mother, has been found guilty of multiple murders, destruction of evidence, and other offenses.

He had killed Saleena and her four children, plus a niece, at their farmhouse in Igatpuri, Nashik, in February 2011, ostensibly over a property-related dispute, buried their bodies on the bungalow plot, and then was on the run. The children were killed

because they had witnessed Tak committing the murder of Saleena Khan, as per the probe. However, after nine months, the killings came to light when the Jammu & Kashmir Police arrested Tak, and the skeletal remains of the six victims were discovered in the farmhouse garden in July 2012.
