In view of the massive outbreak of COVID-19 panaemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs ("MCA") circular dated May 05, 2020 read with circulars dated April 08, 2020and April 13, 2020 (collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") and Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") circular dated May 12, 2020 ("SEBI Circular") pernitted the holding of the AGM through VC / OAVM, without the physical presence of the Menbers.

1. The compliance with the provisiolis of the Companies \&ct, 2013 and the Rules made there under relating to voting through electronic moans (by remote e-voting) and electronic voting (e-voting) at the AGM by the shatehors on the resolutions proposed in the Notice of the $59^{\text {th }}$ Annual General Meeting of the Cempany is the responsibility of the management. 2. The e-voting facility both for e-voting prior to the AGM iremote e-voting) and voting at the AGM by electronics means (e-voting) was provided by Central Depository Services Limited (CDSL).
3. The Equity Shareholders holding shares as on $22^{\text {nd }}$ September, 2020, "cut off date", were entitled to vote on the resolutions stated in the Notice of the 59th Annual General Meeting of the Company.

As per the information given by the Company the names of the shareholders who had voted by remote e-voting through the facility provided by CDSL had been blocked and only those members who were present at the AGM through VC and who had not voted on remote e-voting were allowed to cast their votes through e-voting system during the AGM.
7. After closure of e-voting at the AGM, the votes cast through e-voting at the AGM and through remote e-voting prior to the date of AGM were unblocked and downloaded from the e-voting website of Central Depository Services Limited (https://www.evotingindia.com)in the presence of two witnesses, who are not in the employment of the company. The e-voting data/results downloaded from the e-voting system of CDSL were scrutinized and reviewed, the votes were counted, and the results were prepared.
