AFTER GUJARAT'S DHOLERA...

On cards: 4 smart cities, logistics parks by FY25

New Delhi, 11 March

After building Gujarat's Dholera Special Investment Region, the government is in the process of bringing up two smart cities and logistics parks each by the end of next financial year under the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme.

While Krishnapatnam and Tumakuru, part of the Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC), are being developed as smart cities, Nangal Chaudhary and Greater Noida, under the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC), are upcoming logistics and multimodal hubs, Rajat Saini, chief executive officer (CEO) and managing director (MD) of the National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC), told *Business Standard*.

Through the National Industrial Corridor Development Programme, the government wants to develop industrial cities as "smart cities", converging next-generation technologies across infrastructure sectors.

NICDC, which is in charge of the programme, is responsible for the planning of 11 industrial corridors identified by the government and building 32 futuristic industrial

cities, which can compete with the best manufacturing and investment destinations in the world. Of the 32, four greenfield industrial smart cities have been developed under DMIC.

The 11 corridors will have smart cities, industrial towns, and logistics parks, and will develop dedicated freight corridors, improve road and highway networks, expand railway infrastructure, and reduce transportation bottlenecks.

"Our planning includes identifying two things — supply and demand of industry infrastructure and gaps in infrastructure," Saini told *Business Standard* in an interview.

Sources said the government expected an average investment of ₹25,000-30,000 crore each in the next lot of 10-11 industrial smart cities that are in the pipeline. Its own investment will be ₹1,500-2,000 crore each.

Under the DMIC, 10 projects including industrial towns, investment regions and logistics parks have been planned. The Dholera Special Investment Region, Shendra Bidkin Industrial Area (Maharashtra), Integrated Industrial Township (Greater Noida), and Integrated Industrial Township (Madhya Pradesh) are the four greenfield industrial smart cities that have been developed.

As many as 55 units, including Hyosung, Perkins, Amul, NLMK, Fuji Silvertex, and J-world, have started commercial production while construction is underway in around 60 companies. Additionally, a huge chunk of developed land parcels for multisectoral uses are available for allotment.

Discoms saw power cost, debt rise in step with growing demand

As power demand touched record levels during the last financial year, power distribution companies (discoms) faced escalating electricity procurement costs and a deepening debt burden, as they grappled with meeting their growing working capital needs. Power demand grew at 8.9 per cent between financial year (FY) 2021 and 2023, as against 4.3 per cent between FY14 and FY20.

In its latest edition of the 'Integrated Rating & Ranking of Power Distribution Utilities' report, the Ministry of Power said the growth in power demand and global geopolitical challenges resulted in "an unprecedented increase in national power purchase costs of 71 paise per unit in FY23."

The report said the power price escalation was triggered by two reasons: The rise in quantum and price of imported coal. With domestic coal stocks depleting at power plants, the government took steps to address the mounting power demand, leading to a surge in coal imports.

"Coal imports in FY23 reached 56 million tonnes per annum (mtpa), which was more

Adani Electricity Mumbai tops discoms rating chart

Adani Electricity Mumbai has topped the chart in the performance ranking of power distribution companies for 2022-23, a statement said on Monday. Torrent Power Surat and Torrent Power Ahmedabad were at second and third spots in the 12th edition of Integrated Rating of Discoms released by Union Minister for Power and New & Renewable Energy R K Singh. As many as 14 of 55 distribution companies received the highest A+ rating. Utilities of Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Andhra Pradesh were in A+ / A category, a power ministry release stated.

The coal price in the global market increased substantially during FY22 and FY23, driven by the Russia-Ukraine war and demand surge in countries like India, China," said the report. The average cost of imported coal for India rose to over ₹12,500 per tonne in FY23 from ₹8,300 in FY22 and ₹4,300 in FY21.

Soon, platform to streamline e-waste management

The government will soon come up with an online platform to facilitate the trade of extended producer responsibility (EPR) certificates, a move that will help the country tackle the growing menace of e-waste, like defunct mobile phones and laptops.

EPR is a policy that puts the burden of a product's afterlife on the shoulders of the producer. This means companies are responsible for collecting and recycling their products once they're discarded. The aim of EPR is also to encourage companies to design products that are easier to reuse or recycle from the get-go, reducing waste and pollution in the long run. Companies can fulfil this obligation by collecting and processing their own waste or by purchasing EPR certificates from entities that have exceeded their collection targets. They are tradable credits just like green credits or carbon credits.

The forthcoming platform developed by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) is poised to transform the EPR certificate market, enhancing both transparency and efficiency.

Zopper looks to expand into emerging markets

SC to consider plea against Centre appointing ECs

The Supreme Court on Monday said that it will consider submission for early listing of a petition seeking to restrain the Centre from appointing new election commissioners according to a 2023 law, the provisions of which have already been challenged in the apex court.

"Send an email. We will see," said the Bench comprising Chief Justice D.Y. Chandrachud and Justices J.B. Pardiwala and Manoj Misra.

HC: No grave loss if fact-checking unit set up under IT Rules

The Bombay High Court on Monday refused to grant an interim stay on setting up a fact-checking unit (FCU) under the recently amended Information Technology (IT) Rules to identify fake and false content on social media against the government, noting that no grave and irreparable loss would be caused.

A single Bench of Justice A.S Chandurkar said no case was made out to direct the government to continue its earlier statement that it would not notify the FCU pending hearing of petitions against the IT Rules. The order was passed on a bunch of applications filed by standup comedian Kunal Kamra and others seeking a stay on the notification of the FCU pending the final disposal of their pleas against the IT Rules. The court said the balance of convenience tilts in favour of the government as Solicitor General Tushar Mehta has made a categorical submission that political opinions, satire and comedy are aspects not sought to be linked to the business of the Central government.

Maoist links case: SC rejects Maha govt's plea seeking stay on acquittal of Saibaba

The Supreme Court on Monday rejected a Maharashtra government application seeking a stay on the acquittal of former Delhi University professor G.N Saibaba and others in the Maoist links case, and said the Bombay High Court order clearing them of the charges is "prima facie well-reasoned". A Bench of Justices B.R Gavai and Sandeep Mehta, however, admitted the state government's appeal against the March 5 order of the high court. The Bench also rejected the oral request of Additional Solicitor General S.V.Raju, appearing for the Maharashtra government, for early listing of the appeal and said it will come up for hearing in due course of time.

As per sub-regulation 24(2) and 24(3) of Government Securities Regulations, 2007 payment of maturity proceeds to the registered holder of Government Security held in the form of Subsidiary General Ledger or Constituent Subsidiary General Ledger account or Stock Certificate shall be made by a pay order incorporating the relevant particulars of his bank account or by credit to the account of the holder in any bank having facility of receipt of funds through electronic means. For the purpose of making payment in respect of the securities, the original subscriber or the subsequent holders of such a Government Securities, as the case may be, shall submit to the Bank or Treasury and Sub-Treasury or branch of State Bank of India, where they are encased / registered for payment of interest, as the case may be, the relevant particulars of their bank account.

3. However, in the absence of relevant particulars of bank account/mandate for receipt of funds through electronic means, to facilitate repayment on the due date, holders of 9.63% Tamil Nadu SDL 2024, should tender their securities at the Public Debt Office, 20 days in advance. The securities should be tendered for repayment, duly discharged on the reverse thereof as under:-

"Received the Principal due on the Certificate".

4. It should be particularly noted that at places where the treasury work is done by a branch of the State Bank of India, the securities, if they are in the form of Stock Certificates, should be tendered at the branch of the bank concerned and not at the Treasury or Sub-Treasury.

5. Holders who wish to receive payment at places other than those where the securities have been encased for payment should send them duly discharged to the Public Debt Office concerned by Registered and Insured Post. The Public Debt Office will make payment by issuing a draft payable at any Treasury/Sub-Treasury or branch of State Bank of India conducting Government Treasury work in the State of Tamil Nadu.
