Woods still deciding on Ryder captaincy
Louisville: Tiger Woods brings a lot of uncertainty to Valhalla for the PGA Championship. Some of that has to do with his achy body. And some of that involved the Ryder Cup. The PGA of America still has not settled on a captain for the 2025 matches at Bethpage Black, with Woods as the most obvious candidate. Seth Waugh, CEO of the PGA of America, had said he would be speaking to Woods. "We're still talking," Woods said Tuesday. "There's nothing that has been confirmed yet. We're still working on what that might look like - also whether or not I have the time to do it." The PGA of America typically announces the Ryder Cup captain well before the Masters of the receding year. Zach Johnson was announced in February 2022 for last year's Ryder Cup.

FIFA sets date for first Women's CWC
Bangkok: FIFA finally set a date Wednesday to play the first Women's Club World Cup tournament in January and February 2026. The first edition should involve 16 teams though FIFA's ruling council did not specify how they would qualify or where they could play. Barcelona and Lyon are the top-ranked European teams and have combined to win 10 Champions League titles since 2011. They will meet in the next final on May 25 in Bilbao, Spain. A 32-team men's Club World Cup will debut in June-July next year in the United States with teams qualifying by winning or getting consistently good results in four years of continental championships through 2024. The inaugural men's edition will have 12 European teams and six from South America.

McIlroy files for divorce from wife
Louisville: Rory McIlroy has filed for divorce after seven years of marriage, according to court records in Palm Beach County, Florida, a stunning development going into the PGA Championship. McIlroy and his wife, Erica Stoll, had a storybook meeting during the Ryder Cup in 2012, began dating two years later and were married in 2017. They have one daughter, Poppy, born in September 2020. TMZ first reported on the filing, which was made Monday.

Bentancur furious after substitution
London: Tottenham player Rodrigo Bentancur reacted furiously after being substituted in the Premier League match against Manchester City. The midfielder was taken off in the second half with his team losing 1-0 to defending champion City at the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium. He was then caught on camera repeatedly kicking out at his seat in the Spurs dugout, with studs marks from his boots visible, before throwing his drinks bottle to the ground and eventually sitting down.

MAN CITY ON VERGE OF EPL TITLE

Erling Haaland boots twice in 2-0 win over Tottenham Hotspur

Erling Haaland scored twice as Manchester City beat Tottenham 2-0 and moved to within one win of a record fourth-straight Premier League title.

The three-time defending champion will go into the final round of games on Sunday with a two-point lead over second-place Arsenal.

City hosts West Ham in its last league game of the season, while Arsenal is also at home against Everton.

"The tennis players say the serve to win Wimbledon," the last game, is the most difficult one," City manager Pep Guardiola said.

"We know what we're playing for. The tension is there, the rival is so good. It's why it is difficult, we know that."

Haaland fired City ahead in the 51st minute at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium when he converted Kevin De Bruyne's cross from close range.

He struck his second from the penalty spot in the first minute of stoppage time after



Pedro Porro had brought down Jeremy Doku.

Victory means City is in control of its own fate in the race for the title, despite being pushed right to the wire by Arsenal.

Guardiola is now within touching distance of a sixth league championship in seven seasons. No other English team has managed to win four top flight titles in a row, while City is also looking to secure back-to-back league and FA Cup doubles.

Going into Tuesday's game one point behind Arsenal, Guardiola had warned his players that anything other

than maximum points would bring an end to their domination of England's top division. That only increased the pressure on his team, which was also looking to end a four-game losing run in the league at Spurs.

New India Assurance, electing to bat after winning the toss, managed to post a competitive total of 151 for the loss of seven wickets from their stipulated 20 overs.

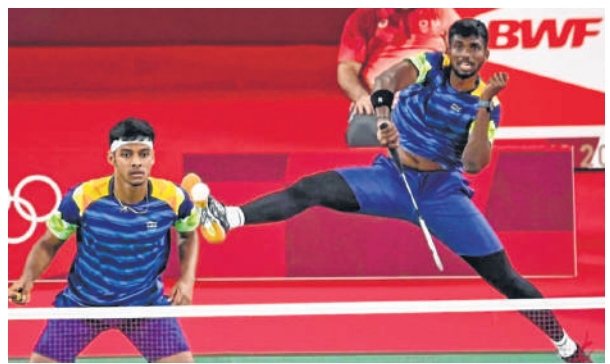
