Debt stricken Sri Lanka signs free trade pact with Thailand

Debt-stricken Sri Lanka signed a trade pact with Thailand on Saturday in a bid to boost trade and investment as the island nation is struggling to recover from its worst economic crisis that hit two years ago. The Sri Lanka Thailand Free Trade Agreement covering trade in goods, investment, custom procedures and intellectual property rights was signed in the capital Colombo in the presence of Sri Lanka President Ranil Wickremesinghe and Thai Prime Minister Srettha Thavasin. Sri Lanka began talks with Thailand on a free trade agreement in 2016.

KYC non compliance led to ban on Paytm Bank

Money laundering concerns and questionable dealings of hundreds of crores of rupees between popular wallet Paytm and its lesser-known banking arm had led Reserve Bank of India to clamp down on tech poster boy Vijay Sekhar Sharma-run entities, sources said. The central bank has ordered Paytm Payments Bank Ltd (PPBL) to halt most of its business including taking

further deposits, conducting credit transactions and carrying out top-ups on any customer accounts, prepaid instruments, wallets, and cards for paying road tolls after February 29. This means customers can access their existing deposits and pay for services with money stored in their wallets till February 29. In and case, RBI does not return top-up for Paytm wallet will stop and transactions through it would no longer can be carried. In a major action against

PPBL, the Reserve Bank earlier this week directed the lender to stop accepting deposits or top-ups in customer accounts, wallets, FASTags and other instruments after February 29. The PPBL sources said, had lakhs of non-KYC (Know Your Customer) compliant accounts and in thousands of cases single PANs were used for opening multiple accounts. "With the resurgence of both leisure and business travel from Chennai, along with a noticeable increase in student traffic, we are committed to providing services that cater to the diverse requirements of our customers," Raicar said. Cathay Pacific would operate flights to Hong Kong on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays from Chennai and on the return direction Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

SBI net profit declines 35 per cent in Q3

The country's largest lender SBI on Saturday reported a 35 per cent fall in standalone net profit to Rs 9,164 crore for the December quarter. State Bank of India (SBI) had earned a net profit of Rs 14,205 crore in the year ago period. The bank's total income rose to Rs 1,18,193 crore in the third quarter

at December-end from 3.14 per cent at the end of the third quarter of last year. Similarly, net Non-Performing Assets (NPAs) also eased to 0.64 per cent against 0.77 per cent at the end of the same period a year ago. On a consolidated basis, SBI Group's net profit slipped 29 per cent to Rs 11,064 crore as against Rs 15,477 crore in the same quarter a year ago. However, total income increased to Rs 1,27,219 crore as compared to Rs 1,27,219 crore in the first quarter of the previous fiscal.

Ahead of IPO, Park Hotels garners ₹409 crore from anchor investors

Aneja Surrendera Park Hotels Ltd, which runs the "The Park" brand, has mobilised Rs 409.5 crore from anchor investors days before its initial public offering. The company has decided to allocate 2.64 crore equity shares to 37 funds at Rs 155 apiece, which is also the upper end of the price band, according to a circular uploaded on BSE's website on Friday. Societe Generale, Citigroup Global Markets Mauritius, Integrated Core Strategies (Asia) Pte Ltd, Baiti Allianz Life Insurance Company, SBI General Insurance Company, Kotak Mahindra Life Insurance Company, and CLSA Global Markets Pte Ltd are among the anchor investors.

At present, promoters and promoter group members hold a 94.18 per cent stake in the company, and the two investors own 5.82 per cent shareholding in the firm. In addition, ICIJ Prudential Mutual Fund (MF), Edelweiss Mutual Fund, WhiteOak Capital, Bandhan Mutual Fund and Quant Mutual Fund participated in the anchor round.

Tesla to pay \$1.5 million over alleged hazardous waste violations. A California judge on Friday ordered Tesla Inc. to pay USD 1.5 million to settle a settlement of a civil case alleging the company mishandled hazardous waste at its car service centers, energy centers and a factory, multiple county district attorneys announced. The complaint filed in San Joaquin County alleged illegal disposal of hazardous waste and violation of laws involving storage and management of the waste, according to statements from several of 25 district attorneys offices in California involved in the case. Tesla did not immediately respond to an Associated Press email seeking comment. The district attorneys' statements said Tesla cooperated with the investigation and acted to improve compliance with laws that were brought to its attention by the prosecutors. "Electric vehicles play a role in environmental betterment, yet it's imperative to recognize that their production and maintenance yield detrimental waste," said San Joaquin County District Attorney Ron Freitas. Tesla owns and operates approximately 57 car service centers and 18 solar energy facilities in California, and manufactures electric vehicles in the San Francisco Bay Area city of Fremont. The settlement includes USD 200,000 to cover costs of the investigation, training of employees and third-party waste audits. "Electric vehicles play a role in
