

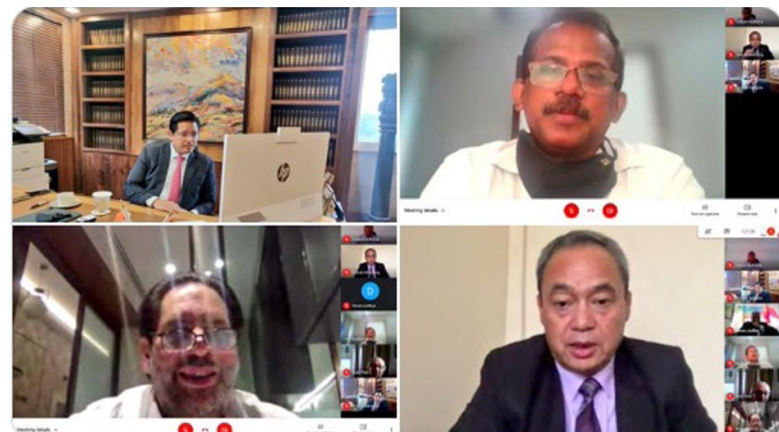

Education on revamp mode in Meghalaya

Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma remains steadfast in his commitment to improving the overall educational outcome in the state



Shillong, November 7: While being committed to the larger cause of improving educational outcomes in the state, Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma remains upbeat about the various initiatives and policies being undertaken. For instance, the

Meghalaya Education Policy has considered different scenarios and has given priority to streamlining the education sector in the state and providing an ideal environment for the students to excel and grow. The chief minister remains committed to the cause of early

childhood education, which is a key priority for Meghalaya. However, various challenges need to be addressed on a priority basis, including lack of information and communication technology (ICT) infrastructure, untrained staff, low quality of learning outcomes and urban-rural disparity, to list a few. Addressing this need, a proposal was put forward to the Chief Minister by Ampersand Group, a leading public-private partnership (PPP) partner in the national and local government's endeavour of transforming the state of education and infrastructure. Sangma acknowledged the efforts of Ampersand Group and directed the education department to take the discussions forward in a tweet recently. "The honorable Chief Minister's commitment to improv-

ing the quality of education is noteworthy and his vision of transforming nearly 6,000 Anganwadi centres into 'Centres of Joyful Learning' will help lay a firm foundation for cognitive and social development of every child while the technology led intervention will provide an alternate opportunity for dropouts to go back to learning," said Rustom Kerawalla, Chairman, Ampersand Group. "This intervention is particularly important to the first generation learners in rural areas and will enable their smooth transition to primary school. Further, Anganwadi centres would need adequate training for teachers on the latest pedagogical approaches along with focus on child nutrition to facilitate a smooth transition," added Kerawalla.

International Webinar on Energy Access and Rural Development held in Guwahati

Guwahati, November 07: Prof Pratap Jyoti Handique, Vice Chancellor, Gauhati University viewed that sustainable development is possible in Assam by ensuring access to affordable, reliable, sustainable, and renewable energy for citizens. There are many opportunities available for researchers, volunteers, social entrepreneurs to join the initiatives of energy access to achieve sustainable development and climate change. Such a goal needs community engagement, systematic persuasion and collaborations -he added. He was speaking an international webinar on energy access and rural development organised NSS Cell Gauhati University in collaboration with Centre for Participatory Action and Social Support (CPASS) on 5th November 2020. At the very outset of the webinar Dr. Ranjan Kumar Kakaty, Director students welfare Gauhati University welcomed the participants and highlighted the relevance of the webinar in context of rural development in Assam and discussed the pertinent issues related to renewable energy and role of National Scheme Service. Irate group of youths from a particular community attacks on duty police personnel including IC inside Morikolong police Outpost, vandalizes entire Outpost

A correspondent: NAGAON, Nov 7: Due to the strict measures against drugs mafias as well as drugs sellers, a group of youths from a particular community went on rampage and vandalized Morikolong Police Outpost on Friday night. The group was so ferocious that at a time it leaped on the on duty police personnel and even attacked physically almost all police personnel including the officer in charge of the Outpost. Besides, the group of youths also tore up several files of records and other case diaries and destroyed the police vehicle kept inside the Outpost. This incident has drawn sharp reaction among the people of the town and also seized the attention to the people as when the police were not secured, how they provide safeguard to the general public in the town. Sources claimed that being informed, police from Nagaon Sadar PS later on rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control and also rescued the other police personnel of the Outpost. Sources said that Morikolong police led by newly appointed officer in charge Anjushri Kalita on Friday afternoon conducted a drive against drugs and other narcotics at Nagaon station road near Morikolong. During the drive police seized a scooter belonged to one Saddek Ahmed for lapses of documents and brought it to the Outpost. Following this, later on around at 8-30pm, Saddek Ahmed along with other 30-40 youths entered into the Outpost and created ruckus there. The group of youths subsequently attacked physically almost all police personnel including the officer in charge of the Outpost and vandalized completely

the Outpost, sources said. Meanwhile Nagaon police on Saturday morning picked up several youths including two NSUI leaders of the town like Parvash Anchary and Iftar Khan.

Sources said that Ayanabh Hazarika along with his younger brother Roktabh Hazarika went to Paradise Lake situated at Nagaon Kothalguri area under Samaguri PS to enjoy the beauty of blue water of the lake as well as its green landscape. During the trip, Ayanabh unfortunately slipped down

into deep water of the lake and drowned into the water. Meanwhile being informed, Samaguri police led by Officer in Charge KK Doley rushed to the spot and tried to trace the body of the youth. But due to darkness of night, police were forced to postpone the search operation on Friday evening. Eventually on Saturday morning, Samaguri police and SDRF personnel jointly launched another search drive in the lake this morning and recovered the body of the youth from the lake, sources said adding further that police had already sent the body of the youth to Nagaon Civil Hospital for postmortem.
