CM Dhama Inaugurated And Laid Foundation For 158 Development Projects Costing 1168 Crores In The Haridwar District



Haridwar (The Hawk): Chief Minister Shri Pushkar Singh Dhama addressed a massive public gathering at the Rishikul Maidan in Haridwar during the Women Empowerment Festival on Monday. On this occasion, he inaugurated and laid the foundation for 158 development projects costing 1168 crores for the Haridwar district. The Chief Minister announced the opening of police and other institutions at the site of the Vambhoolpura encroachment. He inaugurated various projects, including the strengthening of the entire sewage system in the urban area of Haridwar with the help of a 523 crore project approved by the German Bank, drinking water supply in rural and urban areas, development of tourist destinations, and parking facilities.

age, drinking water, and parking in areas such as Haripurkalan, Bhupatwala, Bhimgoda, Harkipauri, Mayapur, Kanakhal, Rishikul, Jwalapuri, Awasi Vikas Colony, Govindpuri, Jagjeetpur, and others.

Chief Minister Shri Pushkar Singh Dhama emphasized the crucial role of empowered women in the progress of any society or state. He highlighted the special contributions of women in the development of Uttarakhand and mentioned various schemes initiated by the central and state governments for women empowerment.

Furthermore, the Chief Minister praised the Haridwar district administration for initiating the 'Dream Project Tara' to empower the future generations both mentally and physically by enhancing the facilities at Anganwadi centers. Under this project, 150 Anganwadi centers are being modernized with amenities such as smart TVs, furniture for children, toys, and training for Anganwadi workers using the nuances of the National Education Policy.

The Chief Minister also acknowledged the efforts towards the revival of the "Meethi Ganga" project and the inauguration of the "Amritkal Anganwadi" project in Haridwar, promoting honey production and sales by local women. He stressed the importance of recognizing women as not just homemakers but also as nation-builders for holistic development.

Chief Minister Shri Pushkar Singh Dhama discussed various ongoing cultural and infrastructure projects in the country under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He announced plans for the construction of the Haridwar and Rishikesh corridor, similar to the corridors in Ayodhya, Kashi Vishwanath, and Mahalak Lok, to establish a distinct identity on the world map.

He concluded by declaring the enforcement of the strictest anti-counterfeit law in Uttarakhand and the recent passage of the Uniform Civil Code bill in the assembly. He urged everyone to dedicate the third decade of the 21st century to women's empowerment.

The event witnessed the participation of dignitaries such as Member of Parliament and former Chief Minister Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank, Rajya Sabha MP Shri Naresh Bansal, District Panchayat President Haridwar Shri Rajendra Chaudhary, BJP District President Shri Shyamveer Saini, Shri Shobharam Prapajati, former MLA Shri Sanjay Gupta, Deshraj Karnawal, District Magistrate Haridwar Shri Dheeraj Garbaly, SSP Shri Pramendra Dobhal, and CEO Shri Prateek Jain.

'No Room For Miscreants In Uttarakhand': CM Dhama Amid Haldwani Violence

Dehradun: Following the violence that erupted in Uttarakhand's Haldwani during a demolition drive last week, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama said that there is no room for 'miscreants' in the state.

The Chief Minister also announced that a police station would be constructed at the place from where the illegal encroachment was removed.

Taking to 'X', CM Dhama wrote, "Now a police station will be constructed at the place where illegal encroachment was removed in Banbhoolpura, Haldwani."

"This is a clear message from our government to the miscreants and rioters that no one who plays with the peace of Devbhoomi will be spared; there is no room for such miscreants in Uttarakhand," he added.



As many as 30 people have been arrested, including 25 in the last 24 hours, in connection with Thursday's violence in the Haldwani city of Nainital. The clashes and violence left five people dead and dozens injured, the police said on Sunday.

Several country-made weapons and live rounds were re-

covered from those arrested, police said.

The state government has asked the Centre for four additional companies of paramilitary forces to be deployed in the district.

Violence erupted on Thursday after the administration conducted an anti-encroachment drive in Banbhoolpura.

After stone-pelting incidents, the torching of vehicles and a mob surrounding the local police station, the administration issued a shoot-at-sight order. Earlier, on Sunday, DGP Uttarakhand Abhinav Kumar claimed that the police personnel, who had gone to Banbhoolpura to assist an ongoing, legally sanctioned anti-encroachment drive, were attacked by a mob.

"The police acted in the lawful exercise of their right to self-defence in discharging their official duties. We have sufficient audio-visual evidence to support this effect. It will be presented in the ongoing magisterial inquiry and criminal investigation," the DGP told ANI. "We intend to act without any bias in full accordance with the law," he added. —ANI

Working To Make Robust Legislation For Polygamy And UCC: Assam CM

Guwahati (Assam): The Assam government is working to make robust legislation for polygamy and the Uniform Civil Code (UCC), said Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Monday.

"We are working to make robust legislation for polygamy, aligning it with Uttarakhand UCC. Earlier, it was coming under civil offence, but we know we are thinking of making it a criminal offence, and after having a discussion with central leadership, a decision will be taken," said Sarma.

Recently, the Uttarakhand State Legislative Assembly passed the Uniform Civil Code Bill 2024.

A Uniform Civil Code (UCC) means that all sections of society, irrespective of their religion, shall be treated equally according to a national civil code, which shall apply to all uniformly. They cover areas such as marriage, divorce, maintenance, inheritance, adoption, and succession of the property. —ANI

Women Will Have The Right To Live; Their Path To Empowerment Will Increase: Uttarakhand CM Dhama On UCC

Dehradun: Emphasizing the importance of the Uniform Civil Code recently passed by the Uttarakhand Assembly, Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama on Sunday said that women will have the right to live, the right to self-defence and the path to their empowerment will increase.

On the second day of his visit to Champawat district, Dhama, while addressing the people, said it was the demand of 'Bharatvarsh' to implement UCC that the Uttarakhand government has brought.

"The demands of the people of 'Bharatvarsh' that women should get the right to equality and the provision of which has been made in the Constitution of India, we have completed that by introducing UCC in Uttarakhand. Women will have the right to live, the right to self-defence and their path to empowerment will increase. They will get employment and move forward strongly," he said.

"We will work on the right of justice. We



added. Further, giving a strong reaction to the recent violent clashes in Haldwani's Banbhoolpura area, CM Dhama said no matter how big a name someone is, no one will be spared. "Today we are fighting all the challenges with full strength. We brought the law of conversion. We have done the work of removing illegal encroachments. Some

people created a disturbance in Haldwani committed arson. We want to say that strict action will be taken against whoever has taken the law into his hands. No matter how big a name someone is, no one will be spared. Whoever works to spoil the system in Uttarakhand, the law will not spare him," the Uttarakhand Chief Minister said. "We are the people who live in peace. Everyone lives together in Uttarakhand. But few people have the wrong idea that if they act like this, then the administration will step back and take no action," he added. —ANI
