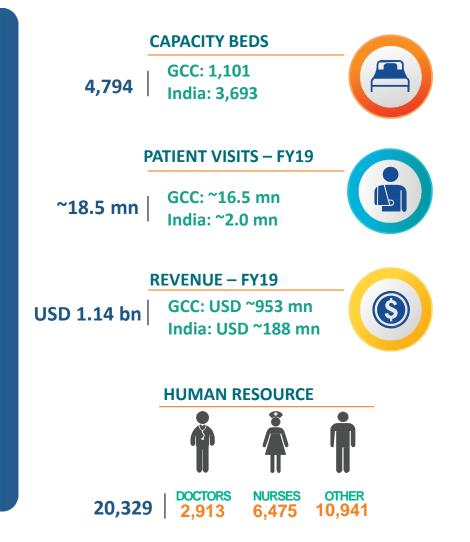

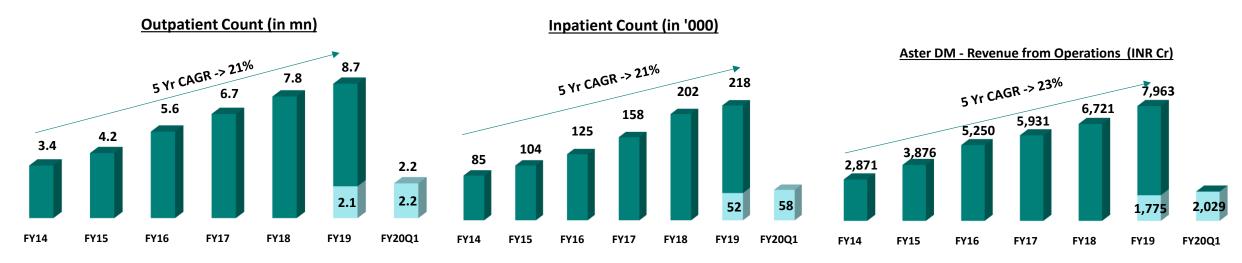

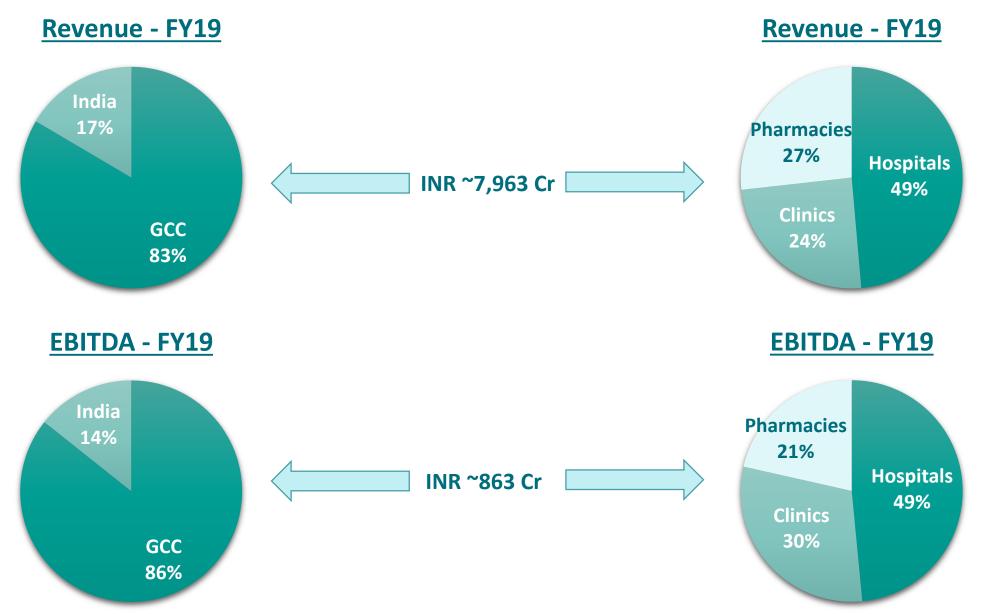

## Aster DM Healthcare – At a Glance

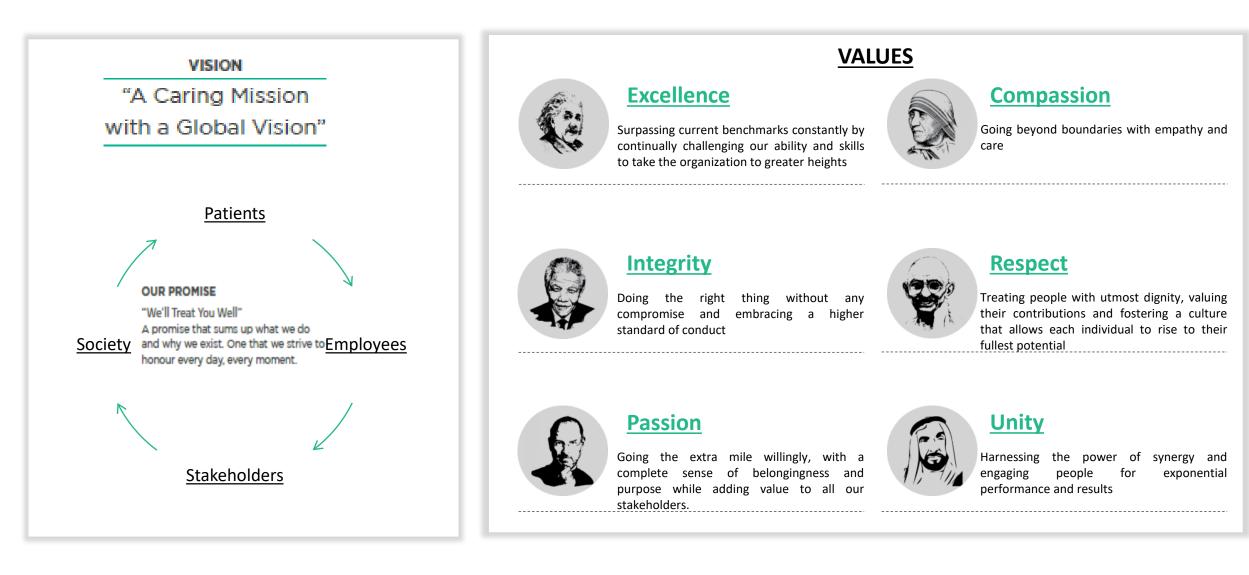

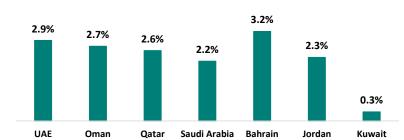

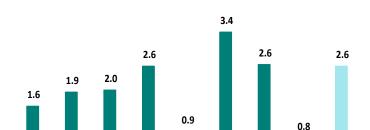
## GCC – Macro Economic Overview

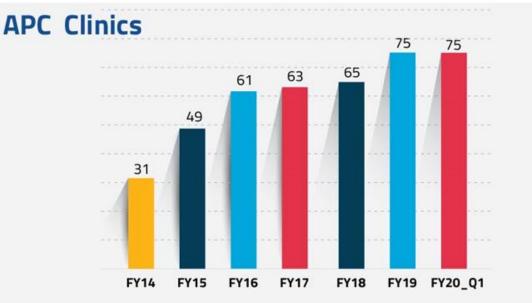
