Asked about the possibility of the Rashtriya Lok Dal (RLD), headed by Jayant Singh, Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) and other regional parties joining the National Democratic Alliance (NDA), the Home Minister said, "We believe in family planning (in general) but not in politics."
"We always want that our alliance grows and we always welcome new allies.

Our ideology has remained the same since the days of Jan Sangh. Those who like to join us can come," he said at the ET NOW Global Business Summit 2024.
When pressed further on the re-entry of SAD in NDA, he said, "Talks are going on but nothing has been finalised." Sukhbir Singh Badal-led SAD had pulled out of the NDA in September 2020 over the now-scrapped three farm laws.

Ten BJP workers arrested for attack on journalist

Ten BJP workers were arrested on Saturday in connection with an assault on senior Marathi journalist **Nikhil Wagle** in Pune, an incident condemned by the Editors Guild of India which urged the Maharashtra government to swiftly address the issue by taking stringent action against those responsible.
The assault took place on Friday evening as Wagle and others were en route under police protection to attend 'Nirbhay Bano' public meeting organised by Rashtra Seva Dal in Dandekar Bridge area of the city.
The complaint filed by a woman, which formed the basis of the FIR, alleged that she and a few others were protecting Wagle's car even



as some BJP workers hurled stones at the vehicle and injured them.
Allegedly incited by Wagle's comments on BJP veteran LK Advani and Prime Minister Narendra Modi after Advani was awarded the country's highest civilian honour Bharat Ratna, the BJP activists damaged the vehicle carrying him, causing injuries to those onboard.
The arrested individuals were named as Deepak Pote, Ganesh Ghosh, Ganesh Sherla, Raghendra Mankar, Swapnil Naik, Pratik Desarda, Dushyant Mohol, Datta Sagre, Girish Mankar, and Rahul Paygude.

Minimally invasive scarless therapy launched

By avoiding traditional surgery and anaesthesia, the risk of complications is substantially decreased and recovery time is minimised. Minimally Invasive Scarless Organ Preserving Therapies hold particular significance in maintaining organ functions and mitigating long-term issues, especially concerning organs like the thyroid, breast, uterus and liver.

Doctors perform reverse shoulder arthroplasty

A team of Goan surgeons have achieved a milestone by performing challenging surgery- Reverse Shoulder Arthroplasty at a city hospital.
The surgery, which was conducted by surgeons Dr Mahendra Kudchadkar and Dr Amey Swar, at Vision Hospital, Mapusa, was made possible with the vital contribution of anaesthesia administered by Dr Bhagyashree Shetye. The combination of general anaesthesia with a block ensured the patient's comfort and safety throughout the procedure and post operative period.
Indication for the surgery included a severely painful shoulder with a long-standing rotator cuff tear, leading to arthritis and debilitating pain that severely limited the patient's daily activities.
In a normal shoulder replacement, the ball of the joint is replaced with

a metal implant, while the socket is resurfaced with a plastic component. However, in reverse shoulder replacement, the positions of the ball and socket are reversed, with the metal implant placed on the socket side and the plastic component on the ball side, the hospital said.
Reverse Shoulder Arthroplasty is not a commonly performed surgery, but its significance cannot be overstated. It is a specialised procedure designed for individuals with complex shoulder conditions, particularly those with rotator cuff tears and arthritis, the doctors said.
As medical technology continues to advance, procedures like reverse shoulder arthroplasty offer new possibilities for patients with challenging orthopedic conditions, reaffirming the commitment of healthcare professionals to excellence in patient care and surgical innovation, the hospital said.

The Chief Minister stated that the low grade ore is in great demand today, and if these dumps are auctioned then lakhs of sq m of land could be reused, probably for agriculture.
"In addition, if this low grade iron ore is exported then the government will be able to earn lot of royalty towards the same," he added.
It was also informed that the IBM will carry out the dump profile and present a study report, which would facilitate the government in the dump auction.
The Chief Minister also said there are 180 locations

around the state where the mining dumps are located, and starting auction of these dumps would start economic activities in the mining belts.
Congress MLA Altona D'Costa said the Bharatiya Janata Party came to power by alleging Rs 35,000 crore worth mining scam in Goa, while the actual amount to be recovered by the government towards mining activities was only around Rs 350 crore.
He also said that out of this amount, only Rs 190 crore has been recovered by the government till date.

17th Lok Sabha propelled India...

Modi also said the 17th Lok Sabha saw 97% productivity.
"We are moving towards the end of the 17th Lok Sabha and we resolve that the productivity should ensure 100% in the 18th Lok Sabha," Modi said.
With 353 MPs, the BJP-led NDA had a brute majority in the lower House.
"Several challenges were met and the country was given an appropriate direction. We can say with satisfaction that the work for which many generations waited for centuries has

accomplished in the 17th Lok Sabha," he said.
"These five years have been of reform, perform and transform. It is rare that we reform, perform and also see transformation. The country will keep blessing the 17th Lok Sabha," he said in his last address to the outgoing House.
The current House had the shortest number of sittings - 272 - among the Lok Sabhas that had a full term of five years since 1952, data compiled by think tank PRS Legislative Research showed.
In his valedictory ad-

dress, Speaker Om Birla said the 17th Lok Sabha had a total of 274 sittings which lasted for 1,354 hours, 345 hours more than the scheduled time.
"A total of 387 hours were lost due to disruptions in this Lok Sabha. The total work productivity of the 17th Lok Sabha has been around 97% which is the highest among the last five Lok Sabhas," he said.
"The 17th Lok Sabha passed 222 bills. During this period 202 bills were introduced and 11 bills were withdrawn by the government."

EPF interest rate hiked to 3-year...

For FY24, the board recommended distribution of Rs 1,07,000 crore to EPF members' accounts on a total principal amount of Rs 13 lakh crore, which was Rs 91,151.66 crore and Rs 11.02 lakh crore, respectively in 2022-23.
Total income recommended for distribution is the highest on record, it said.
Compared with the previ-

ous financial year, there has been a significant growth, the statement said, adding that the income grew by more than 17.39%, while the principal amount increased by 17.97%
This suggests a healthy financial performance and potentially strong returns for the members, it stated.
EPFO has a strong track record of distributing higher

income to its members over the years with prudence.
The interest rate offered by the EPFO tends to be higher compared to other investment avenues available to subscribers, it stated.
This indicates confidence in the credit profile of EPFO's investments, as well as its ability to provide attractive returns to its members, it stated.

Sawant-led panel to meet Union...

They maintained that it is the responsibility of the government to give justice to the aboriginal Goan communities - Gauda, Kumbi and Velip - by reserving assembly constituencies.
The Mission Political Reservation for Scheduled Tribes of Goa, which spearheads the reservation fight, said it will wait till February 16 for the government to make announcement on its long-pending demand.
Speaking to the media outside the state legislative assembly, ST leader John Fernandes and Govind Shirodkar said a notification on delimitation commission should be issued before the Lok Sabha polls so as to ensure that the communities get political reservation for the 2027 assembly elections.
Pushed to the wall by a massive rally taken out by

the Mission Political Reservation for Scheduled Tribes of Goa on February 5, Sawant had assured a delegation that the government would try to persuade the Centre on formation of delimitation panel.
According to the 2011 census, ST population in Goa is 10.23%. Tribal organisations have been demanding reservation of four assembly seats for the tribal communities.
Sawant further said that upon perusing the said proposal, legislative department of the Union law ministry on July 28, 2023 submitted to the directorate of tribal welfare and stated that the readjustment of parliamentary and legislative assembly constituencies was undertaken in accordance with the provision of the Delimitation Act, 2002 by Delimitation Commission and the Delimitation

Order, 2008 issued by the said Commission is still in force. Further, Article 82 and 170 (2) and the Explanation to Article 332 of the Constitution provides that until the relevant figures for the first census taken after the year 2026 have been published, it shall not be necessary to readjust the seats in the legislative assembly of each state.
"Therefore, it is clear that the next delimitation exercise and the readjustment of seats, including the number of seats to be reserved for the SCs and STs, would only take place by a delimitation commission to be constituted for the purpose after the relevant figures of the census taken after the year 2026 are published," he added.

Govt to soon permit sand...

"It is being regulated in terms of Rule 47 of the Goa Minor Mineral Concession Rule, 1985 upon verification of documents," he said.
Sawant also informed that the government charges Rs 600 per trip towards such sand carrying trucks, each truck carrying 8 metric tonne of sand.

Sawant, who holds the mining and geology portfolio, said the High Court had stopped sand mining in the state, following environmental damage to the rivers by way of suction pump extraction.
"The government had then asked the National Institute of Oceanography to carry out a related study of

the Chapora, Mandovi, and Zuari rivers," he informed, stating that based on this study report the government has proposed to restart sand mining by issuing licences.
The Chief Minister also stated that dredging of rivers would provide sand on large quantity, which could then be sold to the people.
