#### Limited Review Report on Unaudited Standalone Financial Results

To:

The Board of Directors of

#### **IL&FS Investment Managers Limited**

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of IL&FS Investment Managers Limited ('the Company') for the quarter ended September 30, 2020 and for the period from April 01, 2020 to September 30, 2020 ('the Statement'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('LODR').
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by its Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 'Interim Financial Reporting' ('Ind AS 34'), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

#### Basis of Modified Conclusion

4. Attention is invited to Note 4 of the Statement which describes the situation faced by the Company in view of the ongoing investigation by Serious Fraud Investigation Office of Ministry of Corporate Affairs (SFIO) against Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services Limited ('IL&FS' or 'the Holding Company'), and its subsidiaries (including the Company). Further, the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) has ordered re-opening of books of account of IL&FS and its two subsidiaries (other than this company) for the past financial years referred in the note. In view of the aforesaid ongoing investigations of the entire IL&FS Group (including the Company) by the SFIO and re-opening of accounts of the Holding Company and two of its subsidiaries by the NCLT, we are unable to comment on the consequential impact(s) upon conclusion of the said investigation and re-opening of the books of account on the financial results/information contained in the Statement.

#### Modified Conclusion

5. Based on our review conducted as above and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3, except for the matter described in the 'Basis of Modified Conclusion' paragraph above impact whereof, if any, not ascertainable presently, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generall

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accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI LODR, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

#### **Emphasis of Matter**

- 6. Attention is invited to Note 5 of the Statement regarding reduction in the Company's fee revenue significantly coupled with the lack of any immediate new fund raise resulting in the reduced estimates of future fee revenue, there is material uncertainty of the Company's continuity as going concern. However, considering management's expectations of Company's ability to, at least, meet its obligations over the next 12 months out of its earnings and liquid assets, the management believes that use of the 'going concern' assumption for preparation of the standalone financial results is appropriate. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this material.
- Attention is drawn to Note 6 of the Statement which describes the impacts of COVID-19 Pandemic on
  the financial results as also on business operations of the Company, assessment thereof made by the
  management of the Company based on its internal, external and macro factors, involving certain
  estimation uncertainties of future periods. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

#### Other Matters

 Due to lockdown, imposed by the Government, to restrict the spread of COVID-19, the processes of quarterly limited review were carried out from remote locations i.e. from other than the office of the Company, based on the data/details or financial information remitted by the management through digital medium. Our report is not modified in respect of this matter.

- (1) The financial results have been prepared in recoordance with the recognition and measurement principles indiction in Indian Accounting Stundard 34 Interim Financial Reporting, notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015, as amended from time to time and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- (2) The above standalone financial results for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2020 along, with comparative quarter have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and assequently approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their respective meetings held on November 11, 2020 in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Chairing Obligations and Directours Requirements) Regulations, 2015. The standalone financial results for the quarter ended as on September 30, 2020 have been reviewed by the stantary auditors of the Company.
- (3) As per requirements of Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 108 no "Operating Segments", based on evaluation of financial information for allocation of recourses and sessessing performance, the Company has identified a single segment is, providing asset management services and other related services. As such, there are no separate reportable business or geographical segments as per Ind AS 108 on operating segment.
- (4) The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA), Government of India, has vide its letter dated October 1, 2018 initiated investigation by Serious Fraud Investigation Office (SFIO) against Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services Limited (IL&FS), the Holding Company and its subsidiaries (including the Company) under Section 212(1) of the Companies Act, 2013. As a part of its investigation, SFIO and Enforcement Directorate (ED) has been seeking information from the Company on an ongoing basis. The investigation is in progress and the Company is fully cooperating with the investigation agencies. On December 3, 2018, MCA on the directions of the National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai (NCLT) has impleaded various Group Companies of IL&FS (which includes the Company) as Respondents to the Petition filed by them on October 1, 2018, Further based on another petition of the MCA under section [30 (1) of the Companies Act, 2013, the NCLT has, on January 1, 2019, ordered re-opening of books of accounts for the past financial year 2012-13 to financial year 2017-18 of 'IL&FS' ('the Ultimate Holding Company'), IL&FS Financial Services Limited ('IFIN' a fellow subsidiary) and IL&FS Transportation Networks Limited ('ITNL' a fellow subsidiary). While the Company, based on its current understanding, believes that the above would not have a material impact on the financial results, the implications, if any, arising from the aforesaid developments would be known only after the aforesaid matters are concluded and hence are not determinable at this stage
- (5) The term of most of the existing funds being managed? advised by the Company has already been over. Other funds being managefad/vied by the company are approaching ent of their term in near future which has resulted/is likely to result in significant reduction in the Company's fee revenue. Management expects that its future income from existing funds being managefad/vied tot quelter with liquid assets held by the Company as at March 31, 2000 will be adequately sufficient to meet the Company's existing and future obligations arising over the next 12 months.

Meanwhile, the ILAFS Board has been working on a resolution plan, with a view to enable value preservation for stakeholders of ILAFS Group. The resolution plan, inter a dis, revolves as led a fasset basinessectropumatic sowned by ILAFS. And in this regard, the ILAFS Board has on December 21, 2018 and September 27, 2019 invited a public Expression of Interest (EIG) for sale of its entire stake in the Company, Accordingly, the Company's plans for new fined raise have been kept on hold pending completion of the stake sale. Further, with the outbreak of the prademic the timelines for the sale process have got delayed and while there is material uncertainty with regard to the stake sale, management believes that use of the going concern assumption for preparation of these financial results is appropriate

- (1) The aforeastic consolidated financial results of 11.8FS Investment Managers Limited (the "Holding Company,") is subsidiatives (the Holding Company, and its subsidiatives (topel-constitute the "Grump") and jointly controlled entities for the quarter and half year ended September 30, 2020 along-with comparative period have been reviewed by the Audit Committee at its meeting held on November 11, 2020 and assisteatestly approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on November 11, 2020 in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Litting Obligations and Disclosure Remirments) Regulations, 2015. The financial results for the half year and quarter ended September 30, 2020 have been subjected to Limited Review by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.
- (2) The financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 3- Interior Financial Reporting, notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015, as amended from time to time and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
- (3) As per requirements of Indian Accounting Standard (Ind. AS) 108 on 'Operating Segments', based on evaluation of financial information for allocation of resources and assessing performance, the Group has individued a single segment i.e. providing asset management services and other related services. As such, there are no separate reportable beariness or geographical segments as per Ind AS 108.
- (4) The Ministry of Corporates Affairs (MCA), Government of India, has vide its letter dated October I, 2018 initiated investigation by Serious Freund Investigation Office (SFIO) against it ILRS and fits subsidiaties (including the Company) under Section 212(I) of the Company). Act a part of its investigation, SFIO and Inforcement Directorate (ED) have been seeking information from the Group on an ongoing basis. The investigation is in progress and the Group is fully cooperating with the investigation agencies. On December 3, 2018, MCA on the directions of the National Company Lew Tribunal, Mumbai (NCLT) has impleaded various Group Companies of ILRS (which includes the Company) as Respondents to the Polition lified by them on October I, 2018. Further based on smother pertition of the MCA under Section 130(I) of the Companies Act, 2013, the NCLF has, on January I, 2019, ordered re-opening of nooks of accounts for the past financial pare 2017-18 of ILRSP, affined and the Political CITINL' a fellow subsidiary). While the Group, based on its current understanding, believes that the above would not have a material impact on the financial results, the implications, if any, arising from the aforesaid developments would be known only after the atoresaid matters are concluded and hence are not determinable at this stage.
- (5) A major portion of the existing funds being managed/advised by the Group are appreaching their and of term over the next 12 months which is likely to result in significant reduction in the Group's fee revenue thereafter. Management expects that its future incurse from existing funds being namaged/advised negether with liquid assets held by the Group as at September 30, 2019 will be adequately sufficient to meet the Group's existing and future obligations arising over the next 12 months. Management believes that, subject to receipt for facessary Board approvals, the Group has adequate funds to commit seed capital for new fund raise as part of its efforts to increase revenues.

Meanwhile, the IL&FS Board has been working on a resolution plan, with a view to enable value preservation for studesholers of IL&FS Group. The resolution plan, inter alia, involves sale of usested-funitenessed-companies coward by IL&FS. And in this regard, the IL&FS Board has on December 27, 2018 and September 27, 2019 invited a public Expression of Interest (Eo) for sale of its entire stude in the Holding Company. Accordingly, the Group's plants for new fund raties have been kept on hold pracifies completion of the stake sale and while there is unstarting uncertainty with regard to the stake sale, management believes that use of the going concern assumption for measuration of these function (each is approximate to the function of the stake sale).
