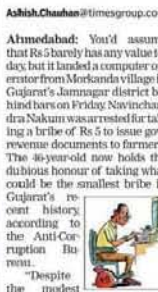

Gujarat ACB mounts sting op, nabs man taking ₹5 bribe

Almohad: You'd assume that Rs 50 lakh has any value today, but it landed a computer operator from Morikanda village in Gujarat's Jamnagar district behind bars on Friday. Navinchandra Nakum was accused of taking a bribe of Rs 50 lakh to issue govt revenue documents to farmers. The 46-year-old now holds the dubious honour of taking what could be the smallest bribe in Gujarat's recent history, according to the Anti-Corruption Bureau.

Despite the modest amount, this bribe highlights the pervasive nature of corruption at even the lowest levels," said R. G. Ghil, assistant director of ACB Rajkot unit.

Nakum, a resident of the village, used to work as a village computer entrepreneur for just two years. Inspector M D Patil, who led the sting operation, explained that they convinced a farmer to act as the decoy. "Nakum has been the VCE since 2013. For each document, the applicant would pay Rs 5-10. Rs 3 would be Nakum's commission, while Rs 2 went to the govt. His job was to provide land revenue documents and ownership letters to farmers."

Remarks on Didi 'beyond dignity', says EC, sends notice to ex-judge

Kolkata: BJP's Tamluk candidate and former HC judge Abhijit Gangopadhyay received a show-cause notice from EC Friday, asking him to explain why "appropriate action" shouldn't be initiated against him for "improper, injudicious" remarks about Bengal CM Manmata Banerjee that prima facie violate model code of conduct.

Acting on TMC's plea that Gangopadhyay be barred from election for "misogynistic and inappropriate comments lacking all sense of dignity," EC said parts of Gangopadhyay's speech at an election campaign rally in East Midnapore's Chhatrapur last Wednesday were "beyond dignity in every sense of the term (and) in bad taste."

"What is your price, Rs 10 lakh? It is because you use Keshu Seth make-up (a personal care products brand)?" he had purportedly asked, referring to Mamata Gangopadhyay, who had some infamously run-ins with fellow judges during his stint at Calcutta HC, was also quoted as saying that Banerjee "sometimes wondered if the chief minister was a woman at all."

Amravati: Twenty-five years ago, a visually challenged baby girl was found dumped in a dustbin at Jalgaon railway station in Maharashtra. With her parents unknown and untraceable, police took the mangled newborn to a remand home in Jalgaon, which fed her and shifted her to a better-equipped rehab home for the deaf and blind 27 km away at Paratwada in Amravati.

Here, she was named Mala Papalkar. But it did not just give her his surname, but also nurtured her talent, schooled her in Braille and made his protégé a trailblazer in the world of the visually challenged and orphaned children.

Mala finished her primary education at a school for the blind and passed high school with first division. She did her graduation in 2018 from Amravati University and post-graduation in arts from Govt Vardar Institute of Science and Humanities. She used to be a writer in every exam. Prof Prakash Tople Patil of Daryapur later adopted her for her education, "Shankarba-ba said."

Noticed a suspect of killing kids found dead: Nearly two weeks after a 32-year-old man allegedly killed his two children in northwest Delhi's Keshavnagar owing to financial problems, his body has been found in Hariwara. He was found to have died by suicide.

India needs a new set of border pacts: AP guv

New Delhi: India needs a new set of border agreements and protocols for China, which can be implemented with clarity and also "create arguments to dispel Chinese dynastic claims with our civilisational counter-claims," AP governor U-Gopal K T Parsaik said on Friday. "We have a peculiar situation with agreements and protocols mainly framed to suit the PLA, with no settlement of boundary cartographic imbalances and an invisible non-designated line to defend," U-Gen Parsaik said. "With 'No Use of Weapons,' we are disadvantaged against LAC. Frequent PLA intrusions violating the agreements is a critical and sensitive issue that needs a firm stance of reciprocity of letting whether (through a 'Quasi' as part of diplomatic/strategic partnership or a tactical 'quid pro quo') in an unmarked boundary situation," he added.

Amid POK unrest, India slams Pakistan's 'exploitative policies'

New Delhi: Amid raging protests in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir, India hit out at Pakistan for its "exploitative policies" denying the local people rights over their own resources. India believes that the protests are a natural consequence of Pakistan's continued policy of systematic plundering of resources from these territories, which remain under its forcible and illegal occupation, said foreign ministry at a media briefing. "Such exploitative policies deny the local people rights over their own resources and the benefits thereof," said spokesman Randeep Jaisankar while reiterating that Union Territories of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh have been, and shall always remain integral parts of India. Foreign minister S Jaishankar had said earlier this week that there is a firm stance against POK. A police officer was killed and more than 100 people, mostly policemen, injured in violent clashes between security forces and protesters agitating against high prices of wheat flour and electricity in POK, according to local media reports.

Delayed bail hearing denied right to liberty

A bench of Justices B R Gavai and Sandeep Mehta passed the order on a plea of Dhall, an accused in Delhi liquor policy case, complaining that his bail plea was not being decided. Senior advocate Kapil Sibal, appearing for the petitioner, submitted that the matter was adjourned after 40 sittings and it had been listed for July and pleaded for early hearing. "Keeping the matter pending for regular bail for almost 11 months deprives the petitioner of his valuable right to liberty," the SC bench observed in the order. The apex court has been reminding the high courts

7th supplementary chargesheet by ED

The filing of the chargesheet came on a day Supreme Court reserved its verdict in the case where Kejriwal had challenged the legality of his March 21 arrest by the investigating agency. On May 10, the SC had granted him interim bail in campaign in the parliamentary elections. This is the seventh supplementary chargesheet filed by ED in the liquor scam case in which at least 30 individuals have been named and accused of involvement. Kejriwal, being the national convener and head of the party, has held responsible for all irregularities of the party and for the alleged kickbacks received from the South group and used for the party's Goa election campaign. "As per the investigation done so far, the proceeds of crime of about Rs 45 crore, which was part of the bribes received from the South Group, was used in the election campaign of AAP in Goa in 2022-23," the ED had earlier said in its memorandum after the arrest of Kejriwal, naming him as the kingpin of the liquor scam.

ED has invoked Section 70 of FEMA which deals with companies to make AAP an accused in the money laundering case. This particular section of FEMA says "every person who at the time the contravention was committed, was in charge of, or was responsible for the conduct of the business of the company as well as the company shall be deemed guilty of the contravention and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished accordingly".
