

3Q & 9M- Highlights



Hi-tech Agri Input Division (Hi-Tech)

- Continued strong revenue growth in India and overseas
- Strong order book position of INR 21,131 mn
- Increase in EBIDTA margin by ~ 1,510 basis (Standalone) and ~750 basis (Consolidated) on YoY basis for 9MFY22

Plastic Division (Plastic)

- Reasonable growth in business on back of subdued seasonal demand
- Unabated volatility in raw material prices impacting margins

Agro Processing Division (Agro)

- Continued growth in revenue
- Strong order book position of INR 10,700 mn
- Natural calamity impacting availability of raw material and operations of onion dehydration business
- Increase in EBIDTA margin by ~730 basis (Consolidated) on YoY basis for 9MFY22

Way forward

- Expediting the completion of Debt Resolution Plan with Indian lenders in the 4th quarter
- Focus on completion of pending EPC projects
- Further improvement in working capital
- Stabilisation of operations

3Q & 9M – Highlights (cont...)



Overall

- Master Restructuring Agreement has been signed with lenders
 - ICA Lenders approved the Resolution Plan via e-voting approved by 99.41% of ICA Lenders by value and 11 out of 12 in number. One ICA Lender who did not e vote has subsequently approved the RP.
 - Execution of "Master Restructuring Agreement" (MRA) was completed by 12 out of 12 ICA Lenders and 100% by value, along with the Security Trustee and Company for the Resolution Plan to be implemented today.
 - In the next few weeks the Company shall fulfill the Conditions Precedent for MRA to be declared "effective" and then the effective date as per RBI Circular dated 07th June,2019 shall be declared by the ICA Lenders.








Revenue Overview: Q3 FY22
