The Scrutinizer's decision on the validity of the Postal Ballot shall be final.

In accordance with the MCA Circulars, Members can vote only through the remote e-voting process. Accordingly, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-voting facility to all its Members to cast their votes electronically. Members are requested to read the instructions in the Notes in this Postal Ballot Notice so as to cast their vote electronically not later than 5:00 p.m. IST on Monday, February 19, 2024, (the last day to cast vote electronically) to be eligible for being considered.

During the aforementioned e-voting period, shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date (record date) of January 05, 2024 may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.
- 2. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that

the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders / retail shareholders is at a negligible level.
