Independent Auditor's Report

TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF RAHUL MERCHANDISING LIMITED
Report on the audit of the Annual Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying annual financial results of RAHUL MERCHANDISING LIMITED (herein referred to as the "Company") for the year ended 31st March, 2024 (Annual Financial Results), attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, these annual financial results:
