## Last 10 years a trailer: PM vows big steps in 100 days of new govt

Begins campaigning in UP from Meerut

Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched his Lok Sabha campaign in Uttar Pradesh from Meerut on Sunday, promising that the forthcoming government would make "big decisions" within the first hundred days of taking office.

He said that the public had merely seen a "trailer" in the past 10 years of his government accomplishing what was previously deemed impossible. He assured that the pace of development would be tremendous in the next five years.

Earlier in the day, the prime minister posted a link to a newspaper report on X, stating that the Congress government in the past had "calmly" ceded Katchatheevu island to Sri Lanka. "This has angered every Indian and reaffirmed in people's minds — we can't ever trust the Congress. Weakening India's unity, integrity, and interests has been the Congress' way of working for 75 years and counting," he posted. At the rally, he cited the Katchatheevu episode as an example of the Congress' sins.

With Rashtriya Lok Dal (RLD) chief Chaudhary Jayant



President Droupadi Murmu conferred Bharat Ratna on former deputy prime minister L K Advani at his residence on Sunday. The ceremony was attended by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, along with other leaders and members of Advani's family

Singh present on the dais, the Prime Minister spoke of his government awarding farmer leader Jayant's grandfather, Chaudhary Charan Singh, the Bharat Ratna. He also discussed his government's initiatives to ensure that sugarcane farmers of the region received better prices for their produce.

He introduced the BJP's candidates for the western Uttar Pradesh seats, including actor Arun Govil, the party's Meerut candidate. Govil is known for playing the part of Ram in the television serial

Ramayana in 1987-88.

Modi stated that his government was working to prepare a road map for the next five years to impart greater momentum to development. He urged people to vote for a Lok Sabha tally of more than 400 for the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) if they wished to see a government that would take significant decisions to build a developed India, send the corrupt to jail, deliver prosperity for farmers, and empower women and provide more opportunities for the poor and youth.

## Stop central agencies' abuse, ensure level playing field...: INDIA lists 5 demands to EC

The Opposition INDIA bloc public rally at Delhi's Ramlila Ground on Sunday concluded with demanding an "immediate release" of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and former Jharkhand CM Hemant Soren.

Congress General Secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra announced "five demands" of the Indian National Developmental Inclusive Alliance (INDIA).

The bloc urged the Election Commission (EC) to ensure a level playing field for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections. It asked the EC to intervene to stop the abuse of the Income Tax Department, Enforcement Directorate and Central Bureau of Investigation against the Opposition and stop the attempts to "financially strangle" the Opposition. It demanded setting up a Supreme Court-constituted special investigation team to probe the "electoral bond scam".

Earlier, addressing the rally, Congress leader Rahul Gandhi cautioned that India would disintegrate if the BJP were to win the 2024 Lok Sabha polls and amend the constitution. Kejriwal's wife, Sunita, and Soren's wife, Kalpana, also addressed the rally. On the dais, the leaders kept two seats, one each for the two leaders currently in jail, to express their solidarity with Soren and Kejriwal. Several other INDIA bloc leaders addressed the rally, including Congress President Mallikarjun

## Katchatheevu, the new battleground for Congress, BJP

The 'ceding' of Katchatheevu, a 285-acre uninhabited island situated between India and Sri Lanka, in the Palk Bay, by the Congress government in 1974, has remained a contentious issue in Tamil Nadu (TN) politics. It is particularly apparent in the context of the attacks on Tamil Nadu fishermen by the Sri Lankan Navy, leading to their arrest and even custodial torture.

With the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) in power in Tamil Nadu when the Indra Gandhi government recognised Sri Lankan sovereignty over the island, the AIADMK has in the past accused the DMK of giving away the rights of Tamil fishermen.

The DMK, however, maintains that it had opposed the Centre's move and ensured clauses were included to protect the fishing rights of TN fishermen and the right to pilgrimage to a shrine on the island. However, a 1976 agreement overturned these provisions, or so it claims.

In 1921, India and Sri Lanka, both British colonies, claimed Katchatheevu, which is nearly 1.6 kilometre in length and over 300 metre wide at its broadest point. A survey marked the island to Sri Lanka, which India disputed. In 1974, Indira Gandhi attempted to settle the maritime border, ceding the island to Sri Lanka for better bilateral relations.

An agreement in 1976, during the Emergency, barred both the countries from fishing in each other's Exclusive Economic Zone. But uncertainty remained over Katchatheevu as it is situated at the edge of each country's EEZs.

With Tamil Nadu gearing up for polls on April 19 and the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) keen to make inroads in that state, the matter captured national attention on Sunday when PM Narendra Modi shared a newspaper article on social media platform 'X', highlighting the Congress' decision to transfer the island to Sri Lanka.
