- One dry-docking in FY24 Vs 3 in FY25 out of which 2 completed Fuel Price MT/INR



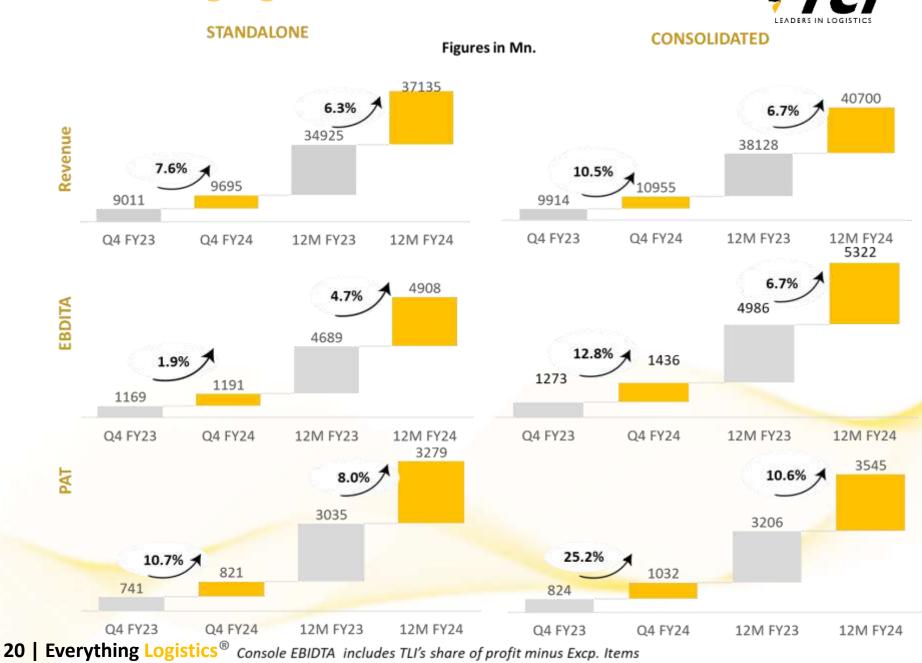
