U'khand Chief Secy Raturi Directs Char Dham Yatra Management To Develop Foolproof Online Registration



Dehradun: The state chief secretary, Radha Raturi has directed the officials related to Char Dham yatra management to take the help of a reputed IT consultancy company to develop a permanent system of foolproof online registration for the devotees visiting all the religious places of the state along with the four shrines.

She asked the official of Yatra management to take the help of all stakeholders associated with Char Dham Yatra, including hoteliers, tour operators, people associated

with tourism and administrative officials to develop this system.

Meanwhile, the Uttarakhand chief secretary also visited the Yatra Registration Office and Transit Camp in Rishikesh and inspected the arrangements and held a meeting with the concerned officials regarding the Char Dham Yatra arrangements.

Raturi said despite facing challenges during the beginning days, the Char Dham Yatra is being conducted smoothly and systematically in the state due to the effective man-

agement of all the officers associated with the Char Dham Yatra management.

The online registration has been started again from Haridwar and currently, about 3000 devotees reached Rishikesh and Haridwar points. All the arrangements are being conducted successfully on the Yatra route as well as in Dhams.

To deal increasing influx of pilgrims in the coming days, Chief Secretary Raturi directed District Magistrates to identify new holding places and create parking places.



She also instructed officials to assess the carrying capacity of vehicles and parking places on the Yatra route soon. The funds will also be released soon, she said.

Besides, the Chief Secretary has also given instructions to strictly follow the trip card system and asked officials to take the help of national tour operators for the successful conduct of Char Dham Yatra. She also instructed instructions to coordinate and communicate with the District Magistrates and district administration of other states. Commissioner Garhwal Vinay Shankar Pandey, District Magistrate Dehradun, Tehri, Senior Superintendent of Police Tehri and officials related to Char Dham Yatra were present in the meeting. —ANI

'Today Indian Army Has Become More Powerful Than Ever Before,' Says CM Dhami

Mohali (Punjab): Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami said on Monday that India has progressed rapidly under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in the last 10 years and that today Indian Army has become more powerful than ever before.

Addressing a public meeting in favour of BJP candidate from Anandpur Sahib parliamentary constituency, Subhash Sharma, at Jujhar Nagar in Punjab's Mohali, CM Dhami said, "Give strength to PM Modi by ensuring victory of BJP candidate Subhash Sharma from Anandpur Sahib. Every vote of the public will strengthen the hands of PM Modi".

He also highlighted achievements of the PM Modi-led BJP government in last ten years.

"PM Modi is serving the country by considering the whole country as his family. In the last 10 years, India has progressed rapidly under the leadership of the PM Modi. Today, India's voice is heard seriously in the world. India has made its mark on the world map. Today the construction



work of IIT, IIM, AIIMS, airports, highways, expressways is going on. India has become the fifth largest economy in the world," CM added.

The Chief Minister said, "On June 1, unite and vote for the lotus button".

All the 13 Lok Sabha constituencies of Punjab will go to polling on June 1 in the seventh and final phase of voting.

The CM added: "The resolution of a developed India will lead to all-round development. G20 was successfully organized in the country. We have a Prime Minister in the form

of Modi Ji who lives, works and thinks only for the national interest. Today the Indian Army has become more powerful than ever before. Today the army knows how to answer bullets with bullets," CM Dhami said.

He also referred to the implementation of the Citizenship (Amendment) Act, abrogation of Article 370 and construction of Ram Mandir.

The BJP has promised to implement the Uniform Civil Code on the lines of Uttarakhand in the entire country (If it comes to power), he said.

The Chief Minister said that under the leadership of the PM Modi, the Kartarpur Sahib Corridor has been constructed. Veer Bal Diwas is being celebrated in the name of the four Sahibzadas of Guru Govind Singh Ji. Their history has been brought before India and the world. Under the leadership of Modi ji, in August 2021, three sacred copies of the holy Guru Granth Sahib of Sikhism were brought to India from Afghanistan with full respect, CM Dhami said.

He said that there are also big places of Sikhism in Uttarakhand. The doors of Hemkund Sahib have opened in Uttarakhand. Hemkund Yatra is very difficult. To simplify the Hemkund Sahib Yatra, PM Modi ji has laid the foundation stone of ropeway there. Ropeway work has also started for Kedarnath, CM Dhami said.

"Before 2014, scams used to come to the fore every day. The opposition is only doing the politics of appeasement. Congress has started the work of snatching the reservation of Other Backward Classes and giving it to a particular class. Aam Aadmi Party has left Congress behind in corruption. The head of their party himself has gone to jail, its people just want to cheat others. Congress and AAP are working together to cheat the countrymen," CM Dhami said.

He said that in Haryana, Congress and AAP are contesting elections together and in Punjab, "These people are fighting among themselves. The condition of Punjab is worse than ever under the rule of AAP". —ANI

Offline Registration For Char Dham Yatra Closed Till May 31

Dehradun: Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhami directed government officials to keep the Chardham Yatra well organized and also said that offline registration should be kept closed till May 31.

Dhmi said this while reviewing arrangements in Chardham Yatra, Manaskhand Mandir Mala Mission, Kainchi Dham and Purnagiri at the Secretariat on Monday, according to an official statement.

The Chief Minister said that the number of devotees in the Chardham Yatra will increase rapidly every year. He said that apart from the carrying capacity of the four Dhams, it is also necessary to assess the carrying capacity of devotees and vehicles at other places on the travel route, it added.

The CM directed that proposals related to parking and basic necessities at the Chardham Yatra routes and important places of pilgrimage and tourism in the state should be sent to the Housing Department. A special plan should be made for every year during the peak period of Chardham Yatra. He said that before the start of Rishikesh-Karnprayag rail service, work should be done with a complete action plan to provide parking and other basic facilities on the railway routes and in Karnaprayag and its surrounding areas, as per the statement. The Chief Minister expressed satisfac-

tion over the smooth running of the Chardham Yatra. He directed the officials of the government and administration to keep the Chardham Yatra well organized with the same dedication, it stated.

The Chief Minister said that offline registration should be kept closed till May 31. He said that further decision will be taken on offline registration as per the Yatra. The Chief Minister directed the Garhwal and Kumaon

Commissioners to work on the route divert plan for the convenience of the devotees in the Chardham Yatra, as per the statement.

The statement added that the CM said that the number of devotees is also increasing rapidly in Kainchi Dham and Purnagiri. He directed the officials to keep adequate parking arrangements along with basic facilities in Kainchi Dham. Adequate parking should also be arranged on the routes leading to Kainchi Dham. Shuttle bus service should be started for Kainchi Dham. A bypass is also proposed for Kainchi Dham.

The Chief Minister gave instructions to im-

prove the arrangements keeping in mind the convenience of the devotees in Purnagiri. The Chief Minister said that the work should be expedited under the Manaskhand Mandir Mala Mission. In view of the convenience of the devotees, work should be done rapidly on infrastructure and connectivity as well as basic facilities. He said that work should be done to expand homestays and other facilities in Ranikhet and Chaukhtia areas to further strengthen the connectivity of Garhwal and Kumaon and to connect both the divisions with the devotees in terms of tourism and pilgrimage, the statement added.

A presentation of 'Yatra Samadhan' mobile application was also done to make the Chardham Yatra smooth and better. The main objective of this mobile application is to provide all the facilities to the devotees on a single platform. Through this application, the police station, hospital, parking and other facilities near the four Dhams will be available. Through this mobile application, all the parties related to the Yatra, BKTC, temple administration, hotels, tour operators, transports will be able to connect with each other. The Chief Minister directed the ITDA and Tourism Department to work to further improve this mobile application, it added. —ANI

IIM Kashipur To Host Norther India's Biggest Scholars' Conclave, Over 300 Scholars From Country's Premier Institute To Participate

• More than 300 scholars from institutions like IIT, IIM, JNU, AMU, and BHU will attend this three-day conclave to promote research. The three best papers will be rewarded.

Dehradun/Kashipur (The Hawk): Uttarakhand's prestigious institute, the Indian Institute of Management, Kashipur, is hosting Norther India's biggest scholars' conclave, Management Education and Research (MERC).

In the three-day-long conclave that will be held between May 31 to June 2, scholars from premier institutes of the country like IITs, IIMs, NIT, JNU, Banaras Hindu University, Aligarh Muslim University, Delhi University will participate to fight for best research paper.

MERC is a platform for doctorate students to present their research to peers, professionals, and other interested parties. This will give doctorate students the opportunity to communicate, collaborate, and network with other scholars and experts of

various backgrounds said the officials.



Apart from the paper presentation, MERC 2024 includes workshops on research methodology to assist participants in improving their methodological rigor. There will be panel discussions on interdisciplinary research and Climate Change and Sustainability. This will promote the sharing of ideas among aspiring researchers and academics.

The institute received 720 applications from across the country, of which 300 research papers were shortlisted, which will be presented in the con-

clave. This is a 400% jump in applications compared to last year, in which the institute received 300 applications. The surprising thing is that 50-60% of the applicants are women.

With a theme of making micro, small, and medium enterprises sustainable, research papers have been received on many subjects, like OBHR, IT, Economics, Finance, Marketing, Operations and Strategic Management, communication, and others.

MERC has thus established itself as a national-level collaborative platform for researchers and academicians. This can be gauged from the fact that this time, there has been a 400% increase in applications as compared to last time.

Apart from the chief guest of the program, Jai

Advani, Managing Director of PwC Company, professors from IIM Ahmedabad, IIM Bangalore, and the University of Colorado Boulder, USA, will be the keynote speaker of the event.

The three best research papers will be awarded with a sum of Rs 25,000, Rs 20,000, and Rs 15,000, respectively.

Professor Somnath Chatterjee, convener of MERC, said, "IIM Kashipur has carved a niche for itself with the huge increase in the number of research projects. We received 300 applications last year which surged to 720 this year. Since IIM Kashipur is highly research-focused, we are extremely excited to host MERC."

He further said, "This event will provide a great opportunity for networking and knowledge sharing for scholars."
