Maratha community misled on reservation issue: Patole

Mumbai, Jan 25 (UNI): Targeting the state's Mahayuti government, Maharashtra Pradesh Congress Committee (MPCC) President Nana Patole alleged on Thursday that the Maratha community has only been "misled" in the name of reservation.

Accusing the Shinde-BJP government of "failure" on the reservation issue, Patole said, "Quota activist Manoj Jaranje-Patil has started a big movement to demand reservation for the Maratha community. Previously, the government held discussions with him, made announcements, and even issued statements that the government would give

reservations to the Maratha community, but so far nothing has happened.

"The government has been misleading the Maratha community. Even after the Maratha Morcha, headed by Jaranje-Patil, announced that they would come to Mumbai, the government did not take immediate steps."

Patole further said that representatives of the government had held discussions with Jaranje-Patil many times on behalf of the Shinde-BJP government.

Two government ministers were constantly in touch with him, but now these two ministers are not to be seen anywhere. "Why are these ministers not holding

discussions now?" he asked. He said the deadline given by Jaranje-Patil to the government for implementing reservations has expired, and the date set by the government too has expired. But even then, no decision has been taken regarding reservations.

"The government is only giving dates to the Maratha community and not taking any decision to give reservations to the community. This attitude is a gross insult to the Maratha community," he said. Patole mentioned that Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis had said that if he comes to power, he will give reservations to the Maratha community within a month.

2 brothers get life imprisonment

Kolhapur, Satara, Jan 25 (UNI): District Session Judge V R Joshi on Thursday sentenced life imprisonment and fined Rs three lakhs each to two brothers for murdering their paternal uncle, who refused to combine agriculture land.

The incident occurred at Dudhebhavi of Phatan tehsil of Satara district on July 4, 2020. According to public prosecutor Ms. Vaishali Patil, two accused brothers are Aniket Hamant Sonwalkar (23), and his brother Shambhura (21). On July 4, 2020,

both in fury attacked with axes their paternal uncle Dnyandeo Mahadev Sonwalkar (40), who refused to divide combined agri-land. In this incident, Dnyandeo was seriously injured and died during the medical treatment. A total of 11 witnesses were examined before the judge, Joshi, and with accepted evidence and arguments, the lawyer, Joshi, sentenced life imprisonment and fined Rs three lakhs each to both accused, while their father (decades brother) and mother, who were also involved in the beating incident, were acquitted.

top three economies in the world. "Raising concern over nepotism in politics, Modi said. "With the power of your vote, you have to defeat 'parivarwad' parties." He said, "Earlier, news of corruption and scams used to become headlines every day, and the scams worth crores of rupees were common. "We are satisfied that we were able to bring the country out of that dark situation. Today it is not about corruption but about credibility," the PM further added. Highlighting the development carried out by the government in the last nine years, Modi said that India's strong infrastructure is proving to be the biggest driver of growth. "From regional connectivity to communication, from mobile towers to optical fibre networks, from semi-conductors missions to Mission Hydrogen, from the aviation sector to the tourism sector—every transformation taking place in the country is for the youth of the nation, for you!" he said. The PM noted that on

January 22, the government announced a big scheme related to solar. Under this scheme, a target has been set to build solar rooftops in one crore houses in the country.

"This will not only reduce the electricity bill, but the government will also buy the electricity generated," he said. Speaking about the importance of a stable government, Modi said, "If there is a stable government, the country takes big decisions, solves the problems that have been pending for decades, and moves forward."

"Our government, with a full majority, ended decades of waiting by removing Article 370 in Jammu and Kashmir. Our government, with a full majority, ended the four-decade wait of the country's ex-servicemen by implementing one rank and one pension for army personnel," he said. Congress will implement 33 percent reservation for women once in power: Alka Lamba

Mumbai, Jan 25 (UNI): National President of Mahila Congress and AICC spokesperson Alka Lamba on Thursday said 33 percent women's reservation will be implemented once Congress comes to power at the centre. Lamba is touring Maharashtra for three days from Thursday.

While interacting with media persons at Tilak Bhavan here she said Late Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi's visionary

leadership increased women's participation in politics by providing 33 percent reservation for women in Panchayat Raj. Congress has been continuously trying to increase the participation of women in politics and took the historic step by fielding 40 percent of women candidates in the last Uttar Pradesh assembly elections. Even though it took 10 years for the BJP government at the centre to decide on women's

reservation, it has not yet been implemented, she said. She said a detailed discussion will be held during these three days regarding the strengthening of the state's Mahila Congress organisation. Bharat Jodo Nyatra and upcoming Lok Sabha elections, Mahila Congress is focusing on getting the maximum seats out of the total 48 Lok Sabha constituencies in Maharashtra. She said women's representation in elected bodies has increased after they got 33 percent reservation in Panchayati Raj institutions. Now Mahila Congress is emphasising that women's representation should be increased in Vidhan Sabha and Lok Sabha also.

The oppressors of women are moving freely only in the states ruled by the BJP, which was simultaneously shouting 'Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao'. BJP MP Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, who is alleged to have sexually assaulted women athletes, is still at large. Although it has been 6 months since the case was filed, no action has been taken.

She alleged that a female student was sexually assaulted in the prime minister's constituency Varanasi by some "criminals" who participated in BJP's campaign for the Madhya Pradesh Assembly polls. The action was taken only after a public outcry.

dealing with the issues of climate change," the President said.

OBC Minister's disrespect from the grand alliance govt: Wadetiwar

Mumbai, Jan 25 (UNI): Assembly opposition leader Vijay Wadetiwar on Thursday criticized the Grand Alliance state government for dropping the names of OBC leader and state cabinet minister Chhagan Bhujbal from the list of guardians for the flag hoisting list on the occasion of Republic Day.

He said that the state government has issued a circular naming the guardian minister along with the names of the respective districts for hoisting the flag on the occasion of Republic Day, but the name of senior Minister Bhujbal is not included.

A senior OBC minister who has held the post of Deputy Chief Minister twice is being ignored by the Mahayuti government.

Wadetiwar said that there is a question about whether the power of senior minister Bhujbal has been reduced or is being reduced.

The people of the state know the treatment given to OBC leaders in the BJP since the time of the late Gopinath Munde.

Therefore, dropping Minister Bhujbal is nothing new.

It was already clear that OBC leaders would be treated similarly in this government. Today, the Mahayuti government has shown the people of the state that the power of OBC Minister Bhujbal is in the government. So, the government's OBC love is hypocritical. This is clear from this, he added.

GENERAL MANAGER'S MESSAGE

Dear Members of East Coast Railway, I extend my warm greetings to each one of you on the auspicious occasion of 75th Republic Day. It is an occasion for us to re-evaluate ourselves to maintain peace and harmony, and pledge to safeguard and strengthen the democratic system and values enshrined in our Constitution.

Under the Mahatma Satyagrah, we have successfully completed Sambalpur-Talcher doubling project this year with commissioning of Sambalpur-Sambalpur City (Main) 155.00 km and some of the other sections that have been commissioned so far are (i) S. Kola-Balaspur (73.00 km) section and (ii) Balugaon-Anandipada (219.19 km) section in Kuttavilas-Anandipada doubling project. 14 RBLs, 07 HOCs and 07 FCBs, have been completed in New line and multi-tracking projects so far.

Under the Mahatma Satyagrah, redevelopment work of 67 stations is being taken up. Redevelopment work of major stations such as Puri, Bhubaneswar and Cuttack is going on full swing. 59 stations in Khurda Road division and 02 stations in Sambalpur division were commissioned. 1147 numbers of special trains (in trips) of the Railway have run during the year 2023-24 for clearing extra rush passengers. We have always given appreciation for our management and facilitation of train passengers during the Rato Yatra this year.

Cross revenue earned upto Dec '23 is ₹1712 Cr. which is 7.0% more than the last year for the corresponding period.
